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What is an UUD?

An Underground Utility District is a boundary within which overhead structures are required to be removed in order to underground overhead structures.

- Provide **reliable service**

- Underground Overhead Utilities
- Three Lanes in each direction
- Storm Drain Improvements
- Water Main Improvements
- Raised median with landscape



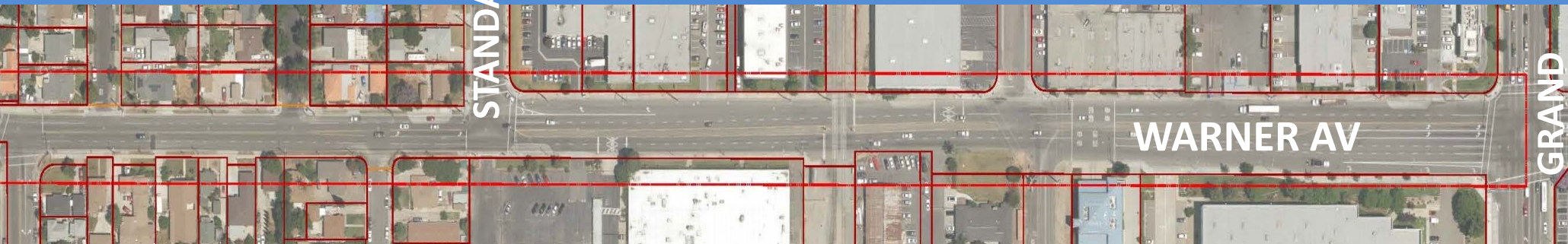

- Rule 20A (see table)
 - No City Cost, Utility Companies fund the project
- Rule 20B
 - City is responsible for majority of cost
 - Funded with other sources (Local Funding)
- Rule 20C
 - City is responsible for all the cost
