2. <u>City of Santa Ana: Request for Consistency Determination for Proposed General Plan</u> Amendment, Zone Change, and Bowery Mixed Use Project

The City of Santa Ana is proposing a General Plan Amendment and a Zoning Text Amendment for the Bowery Mixed-Use Project located at 2300, 2310, and 2320 Redhill Avenue. The proposed project consists of redeveloping the site with a four-phase mixed-use development that would include up to 1,150 multi-family residential units and up to 80,000 square feet of commercial retail and restaurant space.

Recommendation:

That the Commission find the proposed zone change, general plan amendment and the proposed Bowery Mixed Use Project inconsistent with the *AELUP for JWA* per *AELUP* Sections 1.2 and 2.1.4, and PUC Section 21674 which state that the commission is charged by PUC Section 21674(a) "to assist local agencies in ensuring compatible land uses in the vicinity of ...existing airports to the extent that the land in the vicinity of those airports is not already devoted to incompatible uses," and PUC Section 21674(b) "to coordinate planning at the state, regional and local levels so as to provide for the orderly development of air transportation, while at the same time protecting the public health, safety and welfare."
