**Project Applicant:** Ryan Blank, representing Live Nation Worldwide, Inc.

<u>Proposed Project:</u> The above-mentioned property has an existing conditional use permit which allows indoor-only sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages. The applicant is proposing to modify the existing conditional use permit in order to expand the sale and on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages outdoors, to a newly converted front patio. In order to facilitate the project, the applicant is requesting approval of the following land use entitlement: Conditional Use Permit No. 2020-22 to allow the expansion of the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits (Type 47 Alcoholic Beverage Control license) for on-premises consumption in conjunction with an existing concert and dinner facility (The Observatory).


