

GENERAL INFORMATION BUSINESS TAX HOLIDAY PROGRAM

Tax Holiday General Facts:





a. January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 for businesses assessed under the Fixed Flat Rate Tax Category.

b. April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024 for businesses assessed under the Gross Receipts Rate Tax Category.

c. July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 for businesses assessed under the Variable Flat Rate Tax Category.

For any unlicensed businesses who pay all business license taxes for the current tax year within a ninety (90) day period in full, the back tax liability, including penalties and interest, shall be excused.

- For any licensed businesses that are in arrears for business license taxes liabilities, the principal amount of the outstanding arrears must be paid in full in order to qualify for a penalty and interest Tax Holiday.
- For any licensed businesses that under-assessed their business license tax liabilities as a result of improperly underreporting, the principal amount of the under-assessment must be paid in full in order to qualify for a penalty and interest Tax Holiday.
