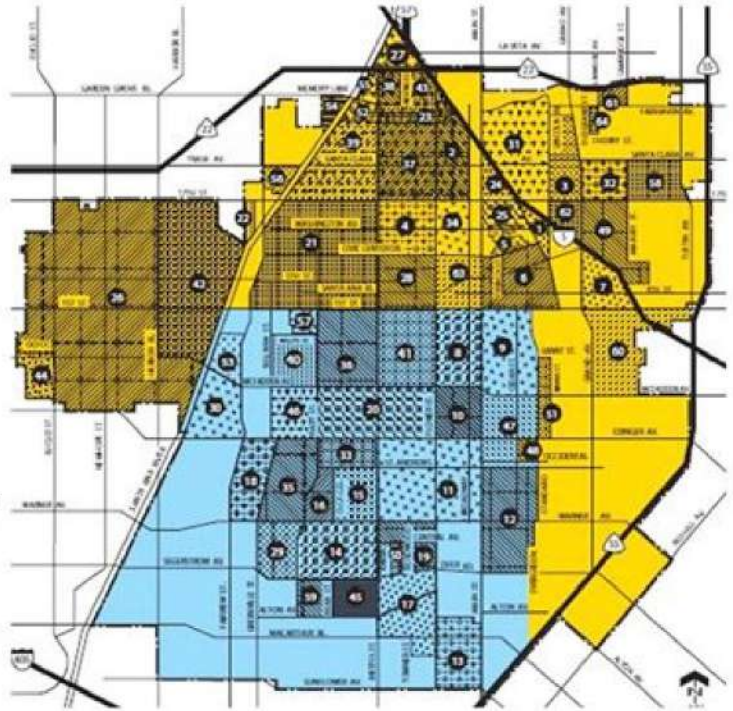


# Community Linkage Forum

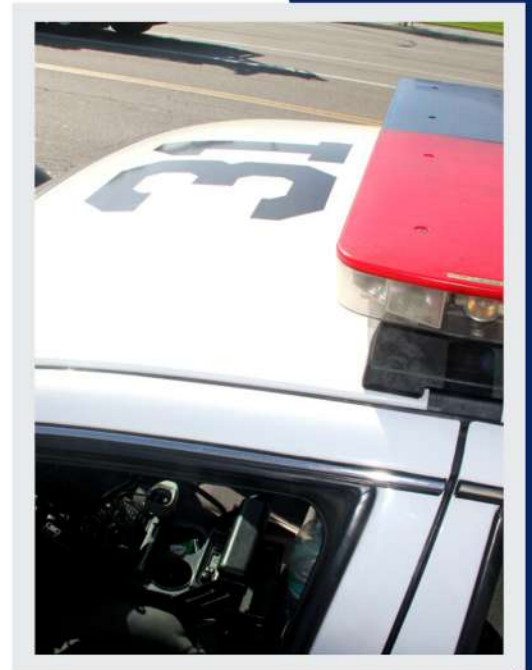
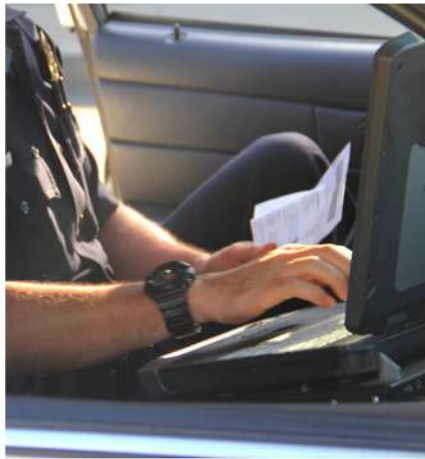
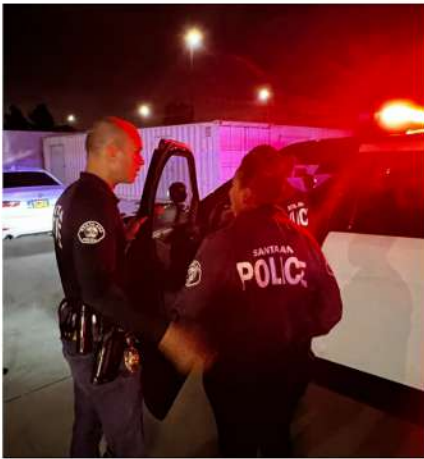
