


The City of Santa Ana finances the development of permanent supportive housing for people experiencing homelessness. Because of these investments in housing, between 2019 and 2022, Santa Ana decreased its homeless population by 44%.





Homeless individuals have been provided with permanent supportive housing through both project-based and tenant-based vouchers through the Santa Ana Housing Authority since 2017.



The City of Santa Ana issues tenant-based housing vouchers to people experiencing homelessness through its Housing Authority.

The City of Santa Ana currently has over 221 permanent supportive housing units in development across five projects. These five projects are in various stages of development and pre-development.
