



The City of Santa Ana finances the development of permanent supportive housing for people experiencing homelessness. Because of these investments in housing, between 2019 and 2022, Santa Ana decreased its homeless population by 44%.

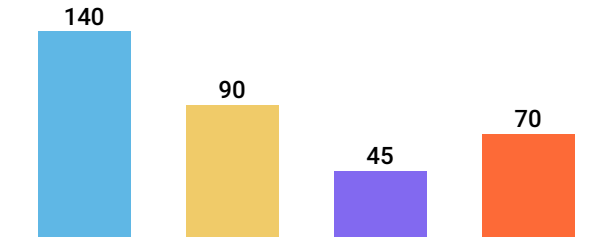
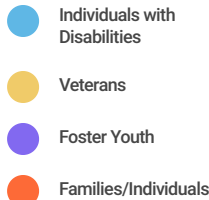

Tenant-Based Housing Vouchers Leased in 2022



Homeless individuals have been provided with permanent supportive housing through both project-based and tenant-based vouchers through the Santa Ana Housing Authority since 2017.

The City of Santa Ana issues tenant-based housing vouchers to people experiencing homelessness through its Housing Authority.
