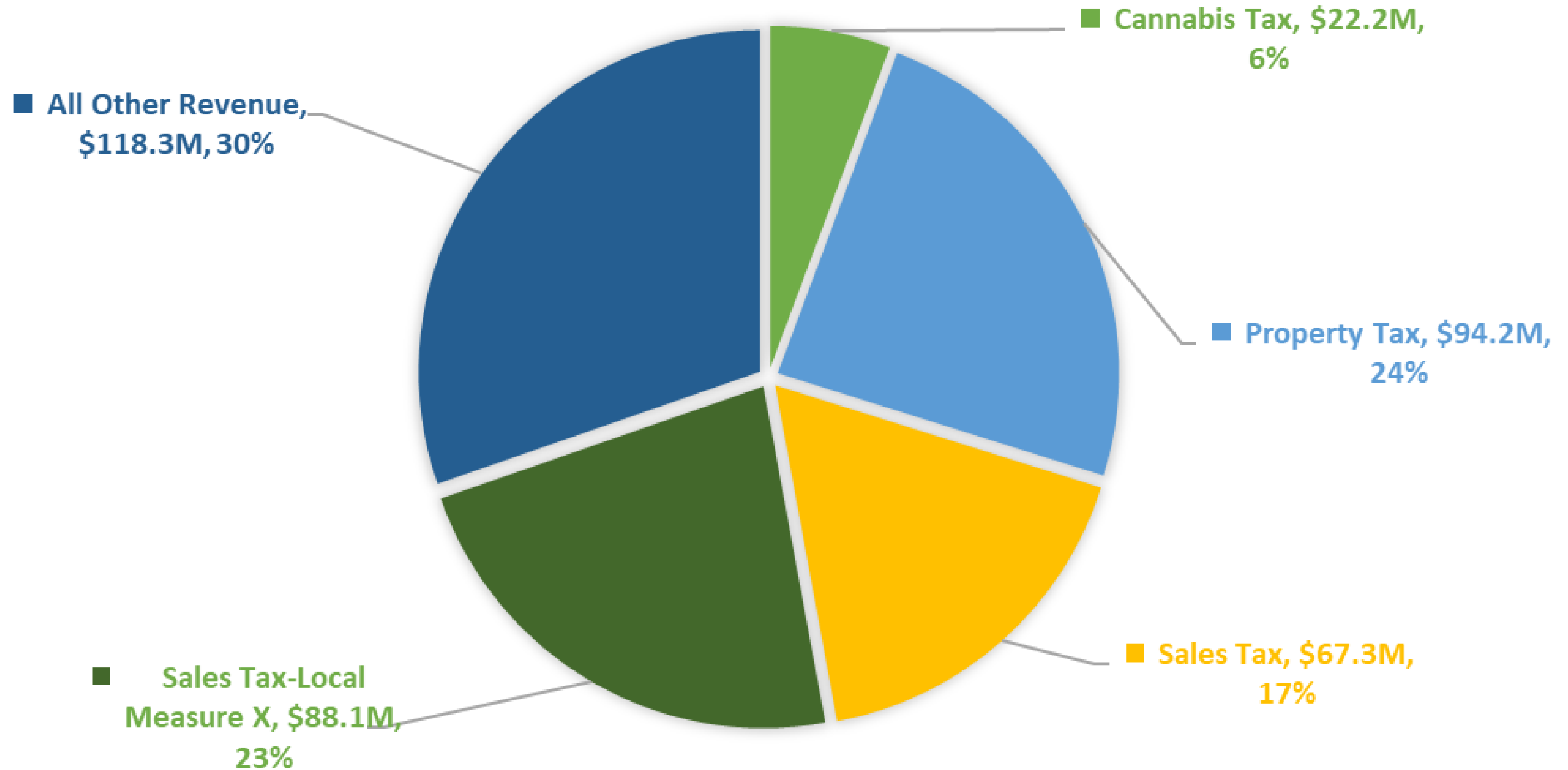

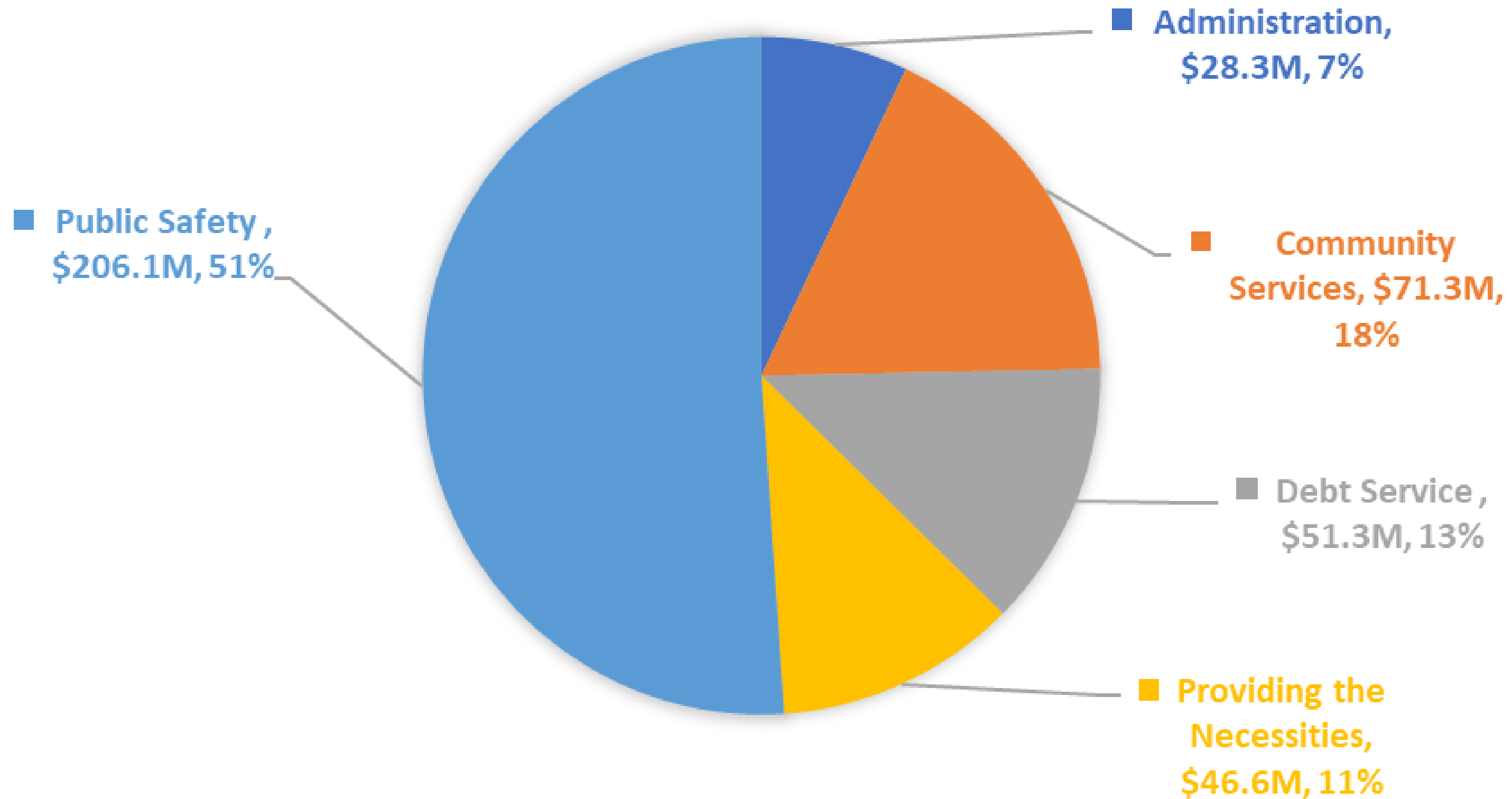

FY2022-23 GENERAL FUND REVENUE - \$390.1M

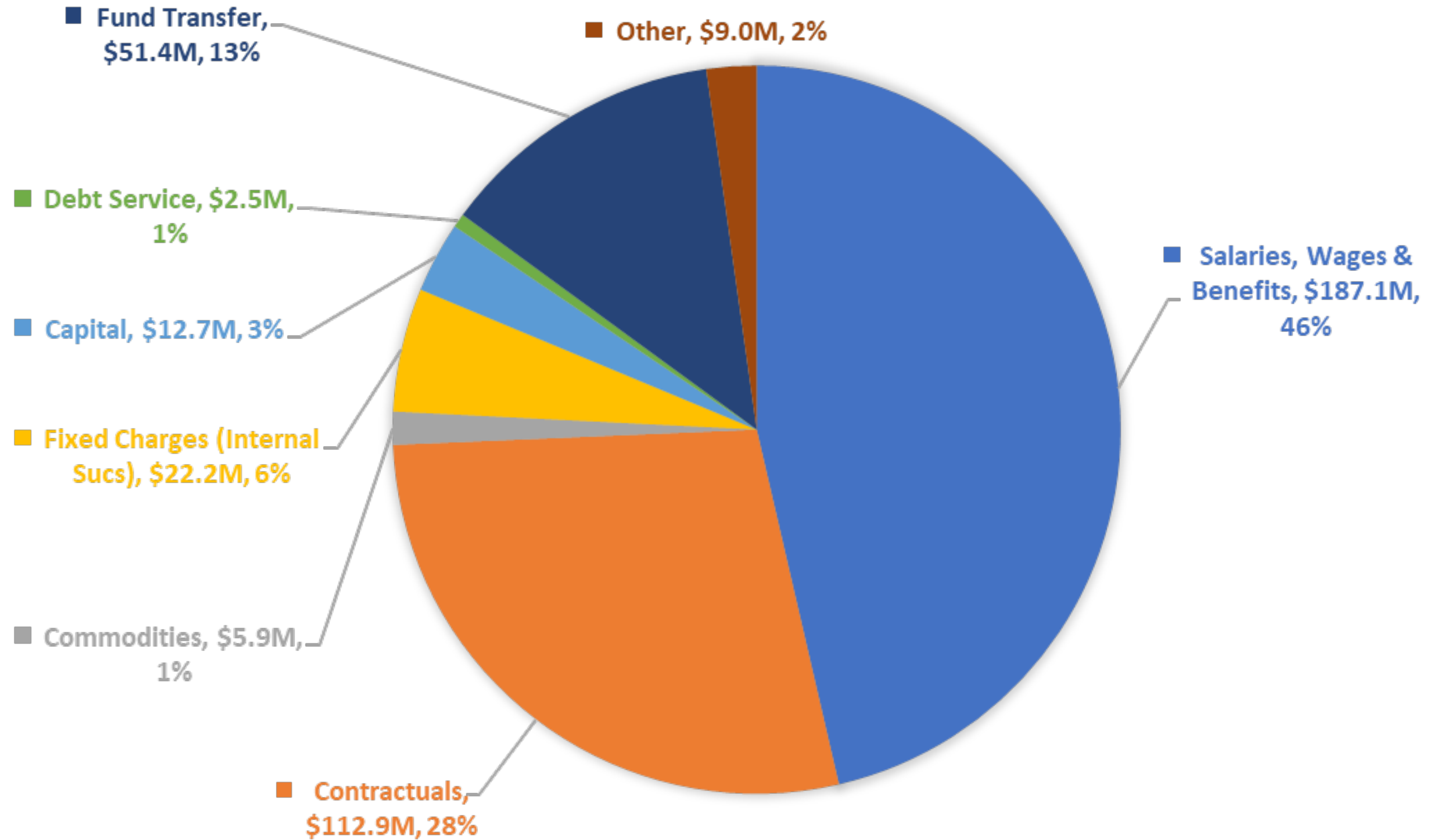


FY2022-23 GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES

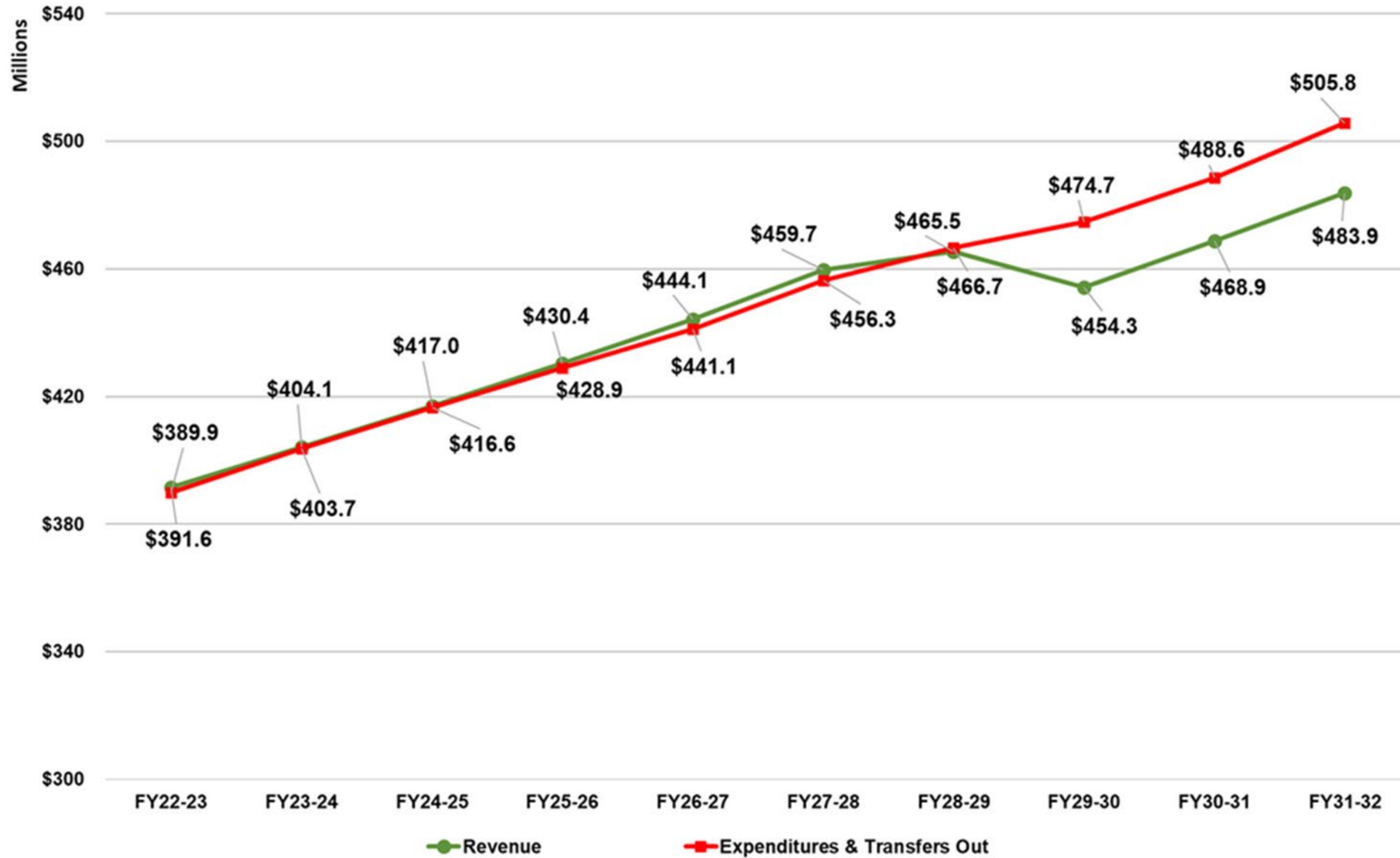
