PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- Upgrade of City stormdrain along E 3rd Street, from Main Street to French Street
- Installation of a subsurface stormwater infiltration system under the 3rd/Bush parking lot
- Street paving and parking lot reconstruction with new landscaping & signage
- Project will reduce flooding Downtown, improve water quality in the Newport Bay watershed, and enhance local water supplies
