

## **Residential Solar Streamline Requirements**

Residential Solar Streamline is only for residential projects less than 10KWA A/C without battery storage.

The following is required for Residential Solar Streamline plan check:

- 1. Solar permit application.
- 2. Electrical permit application.
- 3. Min size 11" x 17" plans with current code cycle and systems less than 10 KWA A/C without battery storage (for paper submittal 2 sets are required).
- 4. Engineered stamp on (Site plan, PV layout, Anchorage spacing, Anchorage details and Manufacturers PV support information).
- 5. Structural calculations, as needed (for paper submittal 2 sets are required).
- 6. Residential Photovoltaic Checklist (for paper submittal 2 sets are required).
- 7. Electronically completed ABC Solar form (Solar America Board for Codes and Standards) (for paper submittal 2 sets are required). <u>http://www.solarabcs.org/about/publications/reports/expeditedpermit/forms/index.html</u>
- 8. Signed Homeowner authorization letter stating, "To install" solar panels. If digital signature validations is required.
- 9. Letter of Authorization from the contractor, if applicable.
