## Tips for addressing Homelessness on Commercial Property

- Put up signs clearly stating that loitering is prohibited, and that people who break this rule will be subject to law enforcement. Contact the Santa Ana Police Department for 602-Limited Authorization for Arrest Form.
- 2) Avoid provoking people, and do not start any physical confrontations.
- 3) Do not permit encampments, and make sure shopping carts, bedding, and other personal items stay away from your building.
- 4) Lock dumpsters, storage areas, and exterior power outlets.
- 5) Make your property illuminate at night with motion-activated lighting.
- 6) Contact City of Santa Ana Planning Department for architectural and landscape ideas to combat homeless encampments and loitering.
- 7) Hire security firms to patrol parking lots and buildings.
