



# UNION PACIFIC & BNSF

OWNED AND MAINTAINED  
PROPERTIES



The Santa Ana Police Department is responsible for general law enforcement within the boundaries of Santa Ana. Some Union Pacific and BNSF owned and maintained properties, including railways, lie within the boundaries of Santa Ana.



As a result, Union Pacific Railroad Police, BNSF Police and the Santa Ana Police Department sometimes share concurrent jurisdiction. Simply stated, if you observe a crime in progress, including tagging, robbery, theft, assaults, indecent exposure, drug sales or consumption, etc., call the Santa Ana Police Department.

If you see an illegal encampment, graffiti, trash, debris, damaged fencing or gates, contact the respective railroad company.

## THE SANTA ANA POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL:

- Will provide courtesy law enforcement services over Union Pacific and BNSF railways.
- Enforce general laws, ordinances and regulations.

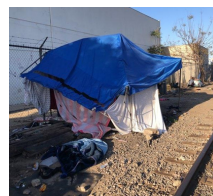
## THE RAILROAD COMPANIES WILL:

- Maintain their respective properties
- Clear all illegal encampments, abandoned property, trash, and other debris
- Graffiti removal
- Repair and install fencing and gates (as needed)



**BNSF** 

Railway owned and operated by BNSF run south from Warner Ave. east of the 55-freeway and veer east to Red Hill south of Dyer Rd.



**UNION PACIFIC** 

Railway operated by Union Pacific run south from Chestnut Ave. east of Standard Ave. to south of Warner Ave. then veer west past Susan St. and south to Sunflower Ave.
