License Your Dog Online: Go to www.petdata.com/santaana. Under License Now, click "Online." The rabies certificate may be uploaded or submitted later by email, mail or fax. Pay with a major credit card. A convenience fee will apply per transaction. Multiple pets can be licensed in one transaction.

License Your Dog by Mail: Complete this application, **Enclose a copy of your dog's current rabies vaccination certificate**, Enclose proof of spay/neuter if not indicated on the rabies certificate, Make your check or money order payable to City of Santa Ana (please do not send cash) **Mail to:** Santa Ana Dog Licensing, c/o PetData, PO Box 141929, Irving TX 75014-1929. Paperwork will not be returned.

Pay In Person: Bring a current rabies certificate, proof of spay/neuter if not already on file, identification if requesting the senior discount, and payment to Santa Ana City Hall, located at 20 Civic Center Plaza in Santa Ana.

City of Santa Ana Dog Information

Make it legal. License your pet!

All dogs age 4 months of age or older are required by City Ordinance to be licensed annually with the City of Santa Ana, and a current rabies vaccination certificate is required for licensing. Licensed pets are far more likely to be returned to their homes if they become lost.

License Term: New licenses will start on the dog's rabies vaccination date or the date the owner moved in to the City of Santa Ana, and will be valid until the last day of the month a year after the rabies vaccination was given.

Renewal licenses will be valid from the date of the last license expiration until the last day of the month one year later. **The rabies vaccination must be valid for the entire license period.** If the vaccination expires earlier, then a new rabies vaccination is required before the license can be issued.

Penalty Fees: To avoid the assessment of a \$48 penalty fee, please remit the payment and/or rabies certificate, if required, by the due date. A penalty may be assessed for the following reasons: late payment, revaccination of the dog after the rabies expiration date, or failure to provide the rabies vaccination certificate.

Dog Limitation: No more than three (3) dogs shall be allowed on any premises within the city. (SAMC Sec.5-50.a)

Permanent Tags: The metal license tag you receive with your first license is permanently assigned to your pet. If a replacement tag is needed, please indicate which pet needs a tag and enclose the replacement tag fee of \$9.
