By way of this letter, I would like to express my interest in re-appointment to the Measure A ICO Committee. As a member of the Sunnyvale City Council for the past 5.5 years, and a current ICO Committee member, I am uniquely qualified to represent the Cities Association of Santa Clara County on this Committee.

During my current term, we have created the auditing functions that are required by law. I have also worked on creating a Public Reporting Portal to provide a transparent and user-friendly dashboard for members of the public to see how their money is being spent. The dashboard can be found at: Reporting Dashboard.

In addition, Sunnyvale has long been a leader in affordable housing and has a decades long commitment and track record of strong and fiscally sound affordable housing project management. Our City prides itself on our successful partnerships with our neighboring jurisdictions, non-profits, and for profit developer partners, with a goal of improving affordable housing opportunities, in addition to other community development efforts. We strive to implement creative approaches to affordable housing, such as down payment assistance programs, various City funding sources, and home rehabilitation opportunities.

The City of Sunnyvale has a very successful affordable housing program which has helped create over 2,000 deed restricted affordable homes including rental, ownership, and special needs housing units. The City currently has over 4,000 residential units in



the development pipeline with over 400 of those being new deed restricted as affordable housing.

If re-appointed as the Cities Association representative, I will continue to ensure that the Cities Association's issues and concerns are clearly represented at the ICO Committee, bond funds are spent properly and fairly, and the program operates consistently with the voter approved measure. I look forward to the decision and the opportunity to continue my service on this Committee on behalf of the Cities Association.
