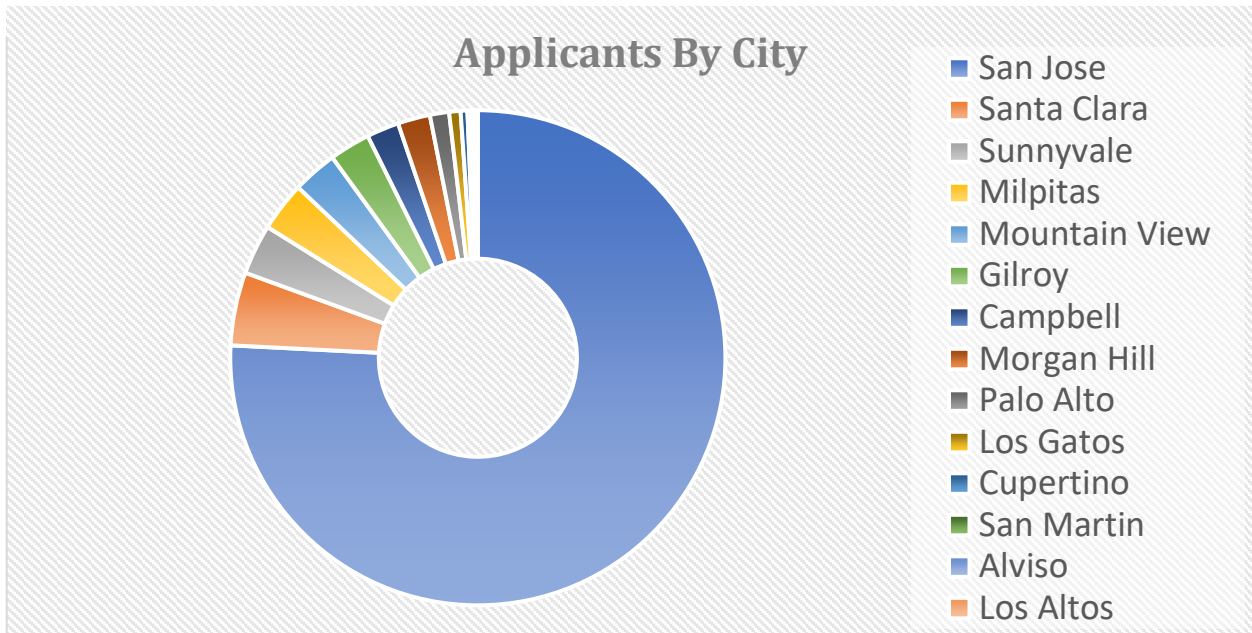


## Homelessness Prevention System COVID-19 Financial Assistance Program

## **Success Stories**

### **Applicant: Maria; Assisted by Adam**

Adam assisted Maria with her application. She is a single mom of three and a server at IHOP who relies a lot on her tips. She got a letter that she is laid-off from work due to COVID. She did apply for unemployment but she needs the income sooner. She didn't have money for groceries so Adam awarded her a \$500 gift card; she is considered extremely low income, and was awarded the full grant she was qualified for.

When Adam called her, she started crying. Adam could hear on the back a little boy asking her "Mom, why are you crying?" Maria was grateful and relieved.

**Applicant: Chris; Assisted by Marianna**

This is a family of 5 whose dad only had left \$3.00 on the bank account as of yesterday (03/25/2020). Mom is a stay-at-home mom. The income that dad brings home every month is \$2,800. Chris is a graphic designer; takes wedding pictures, etc. He told Marianna that COVID started impacting him in early February. He was very overwhelmed. Due to the family situation, Marianna awarded them:

Gift Card: \$250

Award: Over \$3,000

**Applicant: Rachel; Assisted by Malia on 03/25**

Today I spoke with a new mom who was on maternity leave since December 2020. Her name is Rachel. She is a mom of 3 (the youngest is her baby girl). She works as a manager at a Fitness Gym.

She was supposed to go back to work on 03/17/2020 but due to the Shelter-in-Place notice, she is unable to do so. To make matters worse, her Family Paid Leave is expired and cannot reapply. She heard of the Financial Assistance COVID-19 program on TV. Although she applied, she didn't believe it could be real.

She is a manager at the Fitness Gym; earns \$17/hour; and works full time.

I gave her the news today that she will be awarded over \$1,700 plus \$500 in gift card, she started crying. She couldn't believe we were replacing her income; she thanked the County, donors, and those behind the desk processing applications.

It was a nice and touching moment!
