PROTECTS all homeowners and renters by maintaining tax protections for ALL residential property.





ENSURES strict accountability so that money goes directly to our students and communities.

WHO IS IMPACTED BY SCF?




Commercial/industrial properties worth > **\$3M** (combined per owner)

SCF eliminates the tax on equipment and fixtures.


WHAT WILL SCF DO FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY?

New Revenue (Annual) vs. Jurisdiction





FACTS

SCF PROTECTS homeowners, renters, and family farms. It also provides new tax relief for small businesses!



"The \$12 billion will only go towards funding pensions and government, not helping students or our communities." SCF revenue will fund schools and <u>local</u> services with transparency requirements so people know how it's spent.
