





# State Funding to the Bay Area to plan for housing





### ABAG/MTC committed to using REAP:

To enhance the RHNA process

by supporting the Housing Methodology Committee and increasing engagement with local electeds, staff, and stakeholders

To develop a new regional housing technical assistance program

- Technical assistance to jurisdictions to develop compliant housing elements.
- Technical assistance to support community engagement strategies related to "3 Ps" of housing:
  - Protection,
  - Preservation, and
  - Production



### **REAP Advance: \$5.9 Million**

- ABAG/MTC Staff is engaging with local officials to identify needs and evaluate program design options
- RFP issued for Principal Consultant to assist with program design
- RFQ being drafted for deep consulting bench to assist local jurisdictions with Housing Elements updates

### **REAP Balance: \$18 Million**

**Next Steps:** 

Apply to HCD for balance after "substantial progress" made on advance

Deadline: January 31, 2021
