Hi Andi,

I discussed the open positions with Mayor Marico Sayoc and would like to be considered for the ABAG alternate position and/or the Silicon Valley Regional Interoperability Authority position. In addition, I discussed SVRIA position with Supervisor Mike Wasserman, who is supportive ("extremely well qualified and deserving") and would serve as a reference.

Here is brief summary of my qualification to serve:

Matthew Hudes is a Councilmember for the Town of Los Gatos. Working with the Los Gatos Police Department and Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), he has worked to improve emergency communications in the face of new disaster challenges. He is an active Amateur Radio Operator holding a General Class license and serves on the Leadership Team of the Los Gatos/Monte Sereno ARES/RACES emergency communications organization. Matthew graduated from the county CERT academy and serves as an instructor in the highly successful "Ham Cram" Technician licensing class. He has served as Net Control officer during a large-scale drill exercise and regularly hosts the weekly practice net.

For 10+ years, Matthew has served Los Gatos in numerous roles in addition to the Town Council: He has served as Chair of the Planning Commission, Planning Commissioner, Chair of the Historic Preservation Committee, member of the General Plan Committee, the Housing Element Advisory Board, and others.
