# Example Project Types

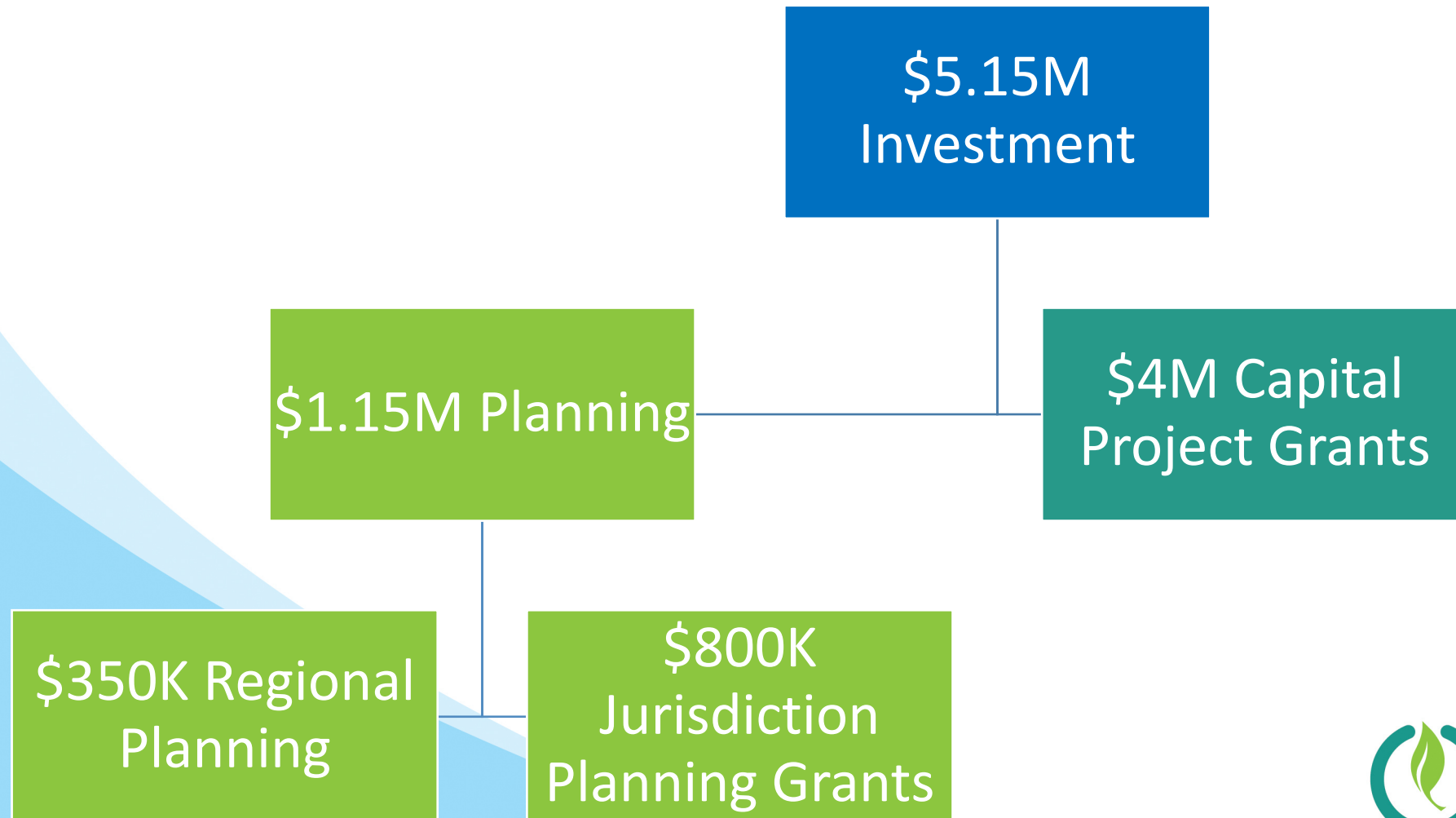
## **Planning**
