

Post relevant messages to specific neighborhoods and custom service areas you provide or the entire municipality.




#### See real-world results

## **Key differentiators**

- Nextdoor ensures neighbors are real people all users must sign up with their real name and address
- The audience is built-in, though members may opt-out
- Communications can be sent to all neighbors or geo-targeted to neighbors in specific custom service areas or neighborhoods
- Staff can send updates, polls, and emergency alerts
- Staff can be assigned to a specific custom service area
- Communications are initiated by staff, not residents
- Posts and comments are archived and available for download from the metrics tab
- Metrics include engagement by post, staff, and posting areas over time



### Policy summary for elected officials & staff

- Join as a neighbor with your personal email at your home address
  - Do not use your official title in your name, however, you may include that you are an elected official in your profile in the about yourself section
  - Post about neighborly things (buy/sell/giveaway stuff, ask for recommendations, ask for help finding your lost dog, etc)
  - Do not conduct official city/county business or campaign from your personal account
  - Direct neighbors to the appropriate city/county department or your work email to answer questions regarding city/county business
- At the discretion of the City/County Nextdoor for Public Agencies Page Administrator, elected
  officials and their staff may be invited to join the City/County Nextdoor page or the City/County
  Communications team may post updates for them.
  - Share updates that help neighbors stay informed, participate in local issues, be aware of safety risks, and prepare for emergencies to build stronger, more resilient neighborhoods
  - The City/County page cannot be used for campaigning, campaign fundraising, announcing campaign events, position statements or any business other than City/County business
