## III. ABAG Announcements

- HESS Tool Update: Somaya Abdelgany demonstrated the updated HESS tool.
  - Jurisdictions are encouraged to explore the realistic capacity module and update data with local findings.
- **REAP Funding Applications**: ABAG is still processing scopes of work for REAP funding, cities can still submit applications.
- Housing Element Review Letters: ABAG reviewed HCD comment letters on Southern CA Housing Elements, this report highlights common problems and overall themes:

- Lawyers' Committee Supplemental Data and Technical Assistance
  - Jurisdiction staff should reach out to Lawyer's Committee staff for any questions or general help with data.
- **Root Policy Research** will join the collaborative as an on-call consultant for data analysis in June.
- General Equity Advisory Group (EAG) Outreach
  - General consensus was that jurisdictions would find individual listening sessions more helpful than a large group panel.

  - Group will adapt regional and state resources to be applicable for Santa Clara County.
  - State requires consideration of farmworker housing for all cities, this group will explore options for jurisdictions with smaller farmworker populations.
  - Suggestion: Farmworker policy focus group/panel

#### VI. Policies and Programs Exercise

- B+D Planning staff led meeting participants in a best practices exercise to clarify policy drafting.
- The exercise emphasized that good policies:
  - Can clearly be accomplished.
  - Have a reasonable timeframe.
  - Incorporate AFFH considerations.
  - Incorporate geographic or neighborhood level factors.
  - Are reasonably detailed.
  - Offer a big picture summary.

#### VII. PBOT: Policy Bot

- Jurisdiction staff can use the PBOT to explore policy options that are directly applicable to specific community needs and a jurisdiction's individual housing element.
