MTC-ABAG Announcements

- Annual Progress Reports Due April 1: Jurisdictions must submit APRs to HCD by April 1, 2023. MTC-ABAG and hosted a webinar explaining changes to the APR form and answering questions from local staff; <u>a recording of the webinar is available on the ABAG website</u>.
- April Deadline to Claim Local Housing Grants: In 2021, ABAG allocated <u>funding for</u> <u>jurisdictions</u> to support local Housing Elements and housing-related planning. Some jurisdictions have not claimed funds, and time is running out given a statutory expenditure deadline. Funds that remain unclaimed by April 2023 may be deprogrammed to avoid returning unexpended funds to the state. Local staff who have not claimed funds should contact MTC-ABAG immediately via <u>HousingTA@bayareametro.gov</u>.
- Farmworker Housing Resources: How to Engage Farmworkers in the Housing Element <u>Process</u>; this guide provides practical advice for outreach and engagement — even if there are not farms or farmworkers living in the community. Accompanying templates can be downloaded and edited to fit your jurisdiction's needs. The guide complements <u>the</u> <u>Farmworker Housing Toolkit</u>, which supports jurisdictions with data, analysis, and potential programs/policies for Housing Elements.
- Regional Housing Technical Assistance Index: MTC-ABAG has produced a range of technical assistance materials for local Housing Element development and adoption. The full index is available here.




Parking Management Planning Grant Call

Category 1: Comprehensive parking management plans

Climate

- Develop a comprehensive parking management plan for a city, county or planning area
- Identify parking-related strategies to minimize new parking development and maximize efficient use of existing parking resources



Category 2: Parking management implementation studies

 Conduct a specific study, analysis or other planning task necessary to complete a parking or curb management capital project, program or other initiative that is otherwise ready to be implemented

Mobility Hubs Planning and Construction Grant Call

A mobility hub is intended to serve as a community anchor and offers a welcoming environment that enables travelers of all backgrounds and abilities to access multiple transportation options – including shared scooters, bicycles and cars, as well as transit – and supportive amenities in a cohesive space

What is an ADU?

Accessory dwelling units (ADUs), also known as "granny flats," "inlaw units," or "backyard cottages," come in many shapes and sizes but are always a self-contained home that is smaller than the main dwelling and legally part of the same property. ADUs must have a kitchen and place to sleep, and can range from small studios under 500 square feet to a moderately sized home with multiple bedrooms.


