1. Welcome/Review of the Meeting Format

Roundtable Facilitator Steve Alverson welcomed the members of the public and reviewed the meeting format. He provided an overview of process for providing public comment, and how he expects everyone to remain cordial and respectful. He noted that a video recording of the meeting and additional resources can be found on the SCSC Roundtable <u>website</u>.

2. Call to Order and Identification of Members Present

The SCSC Community Roundtable was called to order at 1:02 PM by Chairperson Mary-Lynne Bernald. Roundtable members identified themselves. A quorum of the members was present.

3. Consent Item – Approval of a Resolution to Affirm the SCSC Roundtable as the Official Body for Future Actions Regarding the Select Committee on South Bay Arrivals and the South Flow Ad Hoc Committee Recommendations

Chair Mary-Lynne Bernald provided an overview of a letter, dated June 2017, that the congressional offices sent, written to the Cities Association of Santa Clara County, to help establish a long-term forum addressing aircraft noise, with the SCSC Roundtable to act as the official body for any unrepresented cities in South Bay congressional districts. This led into the consent item on the agenda being addressed by Chair Bernald who asked for the approval of a resolution regarding the SCSC Roundtable. The resolution was prepared to affirm the SCSC Roundtable as the official body for future actions on Select Committee on South Bay Arrival recommendations and the South Flow Ad Hoc Committee recommendations.

Two motions were made:

- Member Steve Preminger's motion to approve the resolution as presented was seconded by Roundtable member Kathy Watanabe.
- Member Lydia Kou made a substitute motion asking that the approval of the resolution be tabled for discussion at the next meeting, with edits to be submitted to the chair for discussion next time. The motion was seconded by Vice Chair Matichak.

Chair Bernald noted that this item had now been removed from the consent agenda. The item was opened for discussion.

ACTION: Chair Bernald called for a vote on the second motion first, for the resolution to be tabled for further discussion at the next meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Presentation – Overview of the FAA's Procedure Development Process

Ms. Garcia provided an overview of the FAA's procedure development process, which included

information regarding the Instrument Flight Procedure (IFP) Gateway website where procedures are submitted, and where the Roundtable may submit procedures for review. Ms. Garcia clarified that any procedures submitted to the IFP Gateway will first need concurrence from the airport, and that this process also includes performance based navigation procedures. Ms. Garcia presented another chart showing where the FAA is in the process of reviewing the SERFR procedure, and where public engagement falls into the process for the FAA. Ms. Garcia stated that the environmental review process has already begun for SERFR, which includes further detail and environmental analysis. This environmental analysis will determine if a Categorical Exclusion (CatEx) or an Environmental Assessment (EA) is necessary.

Ms. Garcia provided a summary of the timeline for procedure review, including the FAA's response to the Select Committee Recommendations, which was provided in November of 2017. Within the FAA's responses in 2017, Ms. Garcia noted that a summary of the FAA's review process/timeline for procedure development/review was also provided. Ms. Garcia stated that this process can take anywhere from 8 to 12 months, or could potentially take longer and run about 12 to 18 months.

Ms. Garcia presented a flow chart that maps the environmental review process, noting that throughout the process there are specific points at which the community is provided an opportunity to comment. Ms. Garcia stated that the environmental review process depicted in the flow chart can typically take about six to nine months, which is included in the 12 to 18-month timeframe estimated for FAA implementation of procedures. Ms. Garcia provided additional clarification regarding how public engagement is conducted and defined by the FAA. The FAA's presentation can be found on the SCSC Roundtable website.

Update on the FAA's Review of the Select Committee on South Bay Arrivals Recommendations FAA representatives Ms. Faviola Garcia and Mr. Shawn Kozica provided an update on FAA's actions on implementing the recommendations since the last update was received. The FAA stated that responses were provided in Nov 2018, April 2018, and then in April 2019, and there will be additional responses provided in the summer of 2019 with an overview regarding SERFR and Big Sur overlay.
