RE: Prioritization of Oakland Airport-Community Noise Management Forum

Issues

Dear Ms. Girvin:

The following is the Forum's response to your request for an initial prioritization of

NextGen issues that the FAA and the Forum can work collaboratively on to mitigate

their adverse noise impacts on the citizens of our East Bay communities.

The top two priorities reached by a consensus of the Forum are:

1. HUSSH SID, including OAKLAND SID and CNDEL SID

Reasoning: We included the OAKLAND SID and CNDEL SID with the HUSH SID because the primary goal of these three issues is a modification of departure headings and tracks off the OAK and SFO Airports for noise mitigation to Alameda/Bay Farm Island and west Oakland/Berkeley. Since all three interrelate to departures off the OAK and SFO airports, and the FAA response uses some of the same reasoning/directive references in their responses to the OAKLAND SID and CNDEL SID as they do the HUSH SID, then any work on the departure headings/tracks off OAK and SFO directly relates to the HUSH, OAKLAND and CNDEL SIDS. We believe thoroughly reviewing the HUSSH SID will give the same results (with some slight possible differences) as the

CNDEL and OAKLAND SIDs.

2. WNDSR STAR

Reasoning: The WNDSR STAR as it tracks now takes it over a very densely populated section of the Richmond, El Cerrito, Berkeley, Oakland and San Leandro hills on a very narrow, consistent track during day and night. The altitude of this arrival is only an average of 3500 feet above the homes in that area during level flight. This greatly affects the health and sleep of a very large number of residents.

Other issues we have (TRUKN SID, NIITE SID and others) will need resolution, just at a later date.

Thank you for your consideration, we look forward to scheduling meetings with your technical representatives/subject matter experts in the near future.
