Ryan LeBlanc, Sage Technologies, gave an update on the solar trailers and the progress made on setting up sites around Sherman County to help rural residents be able to access internet. Ryan said that they have been able to deploy Erskine completely, Gordon Ridge, Juniper Point, Tom McCoy's Elevator and Tygh Ridge. These sites are fully set-up and he is working with Gorge Net to set-up new customers. As a test, they set-up Commissioner McCoy and Sheriff Lohrey's personal residence. Both are receiving very fast internet – speeds up to 80 megabits. Gorge Net will be ready to set-up customers the week of September 21.

Solar trailers are being built. Monday, September 21, Ryan and Judge Dabulskis will be driving around Sherman County looking at potential sites and talking to land owners.

Ryan said that he is hoping for late September as a target time frame to work on the Kent Elevator and have customers switched over to Gorge Net if they want.

Ryan thanked Commissioner McCoy for his hard work and years of service.
