1.0 APPOINTMENT SCHEDULE

Windwave Communications has requested utility permits through the county for fiber optic line; Mark met with Blake Lawrence and drove the first phase of the project. They plan is to use a trenchless technology. Mark sees no issues with the planned project.

1.2 Jessica Metta, Sherman County Medical Clinic - Mid-Columbia Economic Development Revolving Loan Fund

Judge Thompson told Jessica that the Corps of Engineers is interested in the possibility of Sherman County leasing Giles French, LePage and Philippi Parks. He will meet with Corps representative and Peter Mitchel from the Port of Arlington on June 18th in Portland. Jessica was invited to be part of this meeting.

Also present for the Medical Clinic portion of the discussion were: Georgia Macnab, Rene Moore, and Caitlin Blagg.

Jessica provided a presentation requesting a loan for expansion of the Sherman County Medical Clinic from MCEDD revolving loan fund. The group cited many reasons for the need to expand the clinic. Among them were: Patient visits are expected to increase due to Cover Oregon and the new CDL requirements, a second restroom is needed for drug screens, there are no dedicated break and consult rooms.

The clinic has shown a profit of about \$7,000.00. They have \$63,000.00 in mortgage debts at 9% interest with an annual payment of \$10,000.00 which they would like to refinance. They are requesting \$250,000.00 from the County. The Health District has \$50,000.00 budgeted for the project in the 2014-15 fiscal year. Judge Thompson said he likes the idea of using MCEDD revolving loan funds. Commissioner Smith told the group the Court could indicate support of the project if official drawings by an architect were presented.

Consensus of the court to move forward as discussed.

1.4 Jaclyn McCurdy – Administrator – Biggs Service District: Budget Committee Meeting

Jaclyn McCurdy and Plant manager Rick Wolf were present.

Rick Wolf, Plant Manager was invited to the meeting by Jaclyn McCurdy. Rick also oversees operation of the Mosier and The Dalles water treatment plants. He gave a brief explanation of the operation of the system.

Judge Thompson asked if any major upgrades are needed. Rick told the Court that the process of loading the bags of solids into the dumpsters needs to be upgraded. He is working on a solution, but does not have a proposal at this time. A new alarm system was added last year to prevent accidental spills into the river. He said some upgrades that might be considered are putting the sampler, flow meter, clarifiers and UV channel under cover. Jaclyn will investigate prices on a small shed type building for cover.

Rocks are still sliding through the fence (coming from under the bridge) and garbage is still a problem on the slope behind Dinty's. Jaclyn will check on the property line to see whose property it is. If it is the county's property the OYCC crew could clean it up this summer. There are safety issues on the access road due to the gate at the end of the road. This is not a new issue and Jaclyn will, once again, talk to Brad DeHart or Pat Cimmiyotti about it.

The Biggs Service District budget was reviewed. Beginning cash on hand is \$138,370.00. Some of these funds could be used for the projects discussed earlier. Jaclyn said she was told that to update the as built plans for the water system would cost around \$20,000.00. Grant funds may be available from IFA, but first it should be determined if the plans need to be updated.
