Grades K-8 will be combined for swim lessons as appropriate. Children will go swimming each week on Mondays and Wednesdays. They will begin with a lesson at 12:40, followed by directed and/or free swim activity. We will take a bus leaving Grass Valley and making stops in Moro, Wasco, and Rufus.

Please send a towel, bathing suite, sunscreen, and a snack for each day. There will be an adult supervising at all times, and trained lifeguards are on duty at the pool the entire time.

- 4) I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Sherman County from any and all liability or claims for damages to the child while being a guest at the Goldendale Pool or while riding the bus.
- 5) I will be responsible for any medical or other charges in connection with my child's attendance at the swim lessons/activity.
- 6) I hereby expressly assume any and all risks which are incumbent with my child(ren) participating in this activity.
- 7) Prevention Program reserves the right to remove a child from the program based on their inappropriate and/or dangerous behaviors or failure to follow bus, pool, or program rules.
- 8) If you are interested in volunteering to ride along on the bus for additional supervision of the children, please check the box. Even if you can only ride one day it is helpful.

The swimming pool's phone number is 509-773-0506 and address is 401 N. King Street, Goldendale, WA

Lap Pool Depth: 3 ½ ft. to 5 ½ ft. (no diving allowed)

Lap Pool Size: 25 yards with 6 lanes (45ft X 75ft)

Average Pool Temp: 83 degrees

Wade Pool: zero depth to 1 ½ ft.

Average Pool Temp: 85 degrees

- The dome over the pool will be removed in June so the pools will be outdoors and the sun will likely be shining, thus we strongly encourage swimmers to have sun screen.
- Lifeguards and swim instructors: All lifeguards and swim instructors have their American Red Cross Lifeguard certification (lifeguarding, 1st aid, CPR, & AED). They will also go through pre-employment background checks and drug screens.
- Storage of personnel belongings: We have "green bags" that are labeled with numbers and swimmers can use them at no cost. Swimmers can put their stuff in the bag and bring the bag to the lifeguard office for safe keeping and simply ask for "bag #" and the staff will give them their bag. Or they can take the bag out on the deck. They can also bring backpacks etc. and they can be stored in the lifeguard office. We strongly discourage having anything left in the locker rooms as you never know when someone who is less than honest may wander through and take something.
- We have a concession stand that sells various snacks (water, soda, otter pops, cookies, chips, string cheese, yogurt, some candy and some swim accessories). Children can also bring a snack with them. We just ask that no glass containers are brought to the facility. Also we have plenty of garbage cans and hope they will be used!

Bus times are best estimate – be there at least 5 minutes early and have your child ready, bus will depart promptly to ensure kids arrive in time for swim lessons. A parent **MUST** be present at pick up and drop off for Kindergarten/1st Grade kids. You are welcome to transport your child yourself.
