\*\*EVERY DAY, please be sure your child has a towel, bathing suit, sunscreen, and a snack for each day. Our bus will remain peanut free. If your child brings snacks or a lunch containing peanuts, they will need to eat at a designated table during the free swim time and wash thoroughly before returning to play.

# Goldendale Pool Central Klickitat County Park and Recreational District

The swimming pool's phone number is 509-773-0506 and address is 401 N. King Street, Goldendale, WA

. There will be at least one adult from Sherman County supervising at all times, and trained lifeguards are on duty the entire time.

Lap Pool Depth: 3 ½ ft. to 5 ½ ft. (no diving allowed) Lap Pool Size: 25 yards with 6 lanes (45ft X 75ft)

Average Pool Temp: 83 degrees (<u>Typically the first visit or two, the water is still a bit chilly.</u>)

Wade Pool: zero depth to 1 ½ ft. Average Pool Temp: 85 degrees

- The dome over the pool will be removed in June so the pools will be outdoors and the sun will likely be shining, thus we strongly encourage swimmers to have sun screen AND reapply while at the pool.
- Lifeguards and swim instructors: All lifeguards and swim instructors have their American Red Cross Lifeguard certification (lifeguarding, 1<sup>st</sup> aid, CPR, & AED). They will also go through pre-employment background checks and drug screens. Parent volunteers are NOT screened as we often do not know they are coming until they get on the bus. If a county employee is unable to attend, we will find someone who has been screened to supervise that day.
- Storage of personal belongings: The pool facility has "green bags" that are labeled with numbers and swimmers can use them at no cost. Swimmers can put their stuff in the bag and bring the bag to the lifeguard office for safe keeping and simply ask for "bag #" and the staff will give them their bag. Or they can take the bag out on the deck. They can also bring backpacks etc. and they can be stored in the lifeguard office. We strongly discourage having anything left in the locker rooms as you never know when someone who is less than honest may wander through and take something.
- The pool has a concession stand that sells various snacks (water, soda, otter pops, cookies, chips, string cheese, yogurt, some candy and some swim accessories). Children can also bring a snack with them. We just ask that no glass containers are brought to the facility. Also we have plenty of garbage cans and hope they will be used!
- The kids seem to be thirstiest on the bus ride home. If a refillable water bottle is an option, please send it.

Bus times are best estimate – be there at least 5 minutes early and have your child ready, bus will depart promptly to ensure kids arrive in time for swim lessons. A parent MUST be present at pick up and drop off for Kindergarten/1<sup>st</sup> Grade kids. You are welcome to transport your child yourself.
