

 - Churches
- What/Who is allowed to be funded through this grant
 - Businesses that are headquartered in Oregon and have a business operation in Sherman County.
 - 501(c) (3)
 - Sherman Development League – Carrie Pipinich will check into this
 - Individual contractors
 - Sole proprietors
- When do expenses have to have occurred
 - March 2020 – December 30, 2020
- When do counties have to report
 - Counties have to report by January 5, 2021




