**WHEREAS**, records indicate that the population of Sherman County has declined since 1960; and

**WHEREAS**, this decrease poses a serious threat to economic development and the overall livability climate of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, certain stores and services require a minimum population level to service and contribute to a viable community standard; and

**WHEREAS**, Sherman County has been blessed with revenue received from wind projects and desires to use a portion of these funds as an incentive to residents to remain and invest in the County:

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Court of the COUNTY OF SHERMAN, OREGON, hereby ORDAINS as follows:

### 1. Section - Purpose.

It is the purpose of this Ordinance to encourage and promote the act of residing in a home in Sherman County, which in turn facilitates economic development and stability to Sherman County.

### 2. <u>Section - Definitions.</u>

The following definitions apply to this Ordinance:

a. <u>Household</u>. A dwelling unit, located within Sherman County, which is occupied by residents, at least one of which is over the age of eighteen (18) and has resided

within such dwelling unit for a period in excess of one (1) year. The occupants of the dwelling can be owners or renters, but must have occupied the dwelling for the requisite period.

- b. <u>Head of Household</u>. The person designated by the household, either the mother, father, or person appointed by the household to file the claim to receive the resident incentive payment. Only those persons qualified by meeting age and residency requirements may be certified as the head of household to make a claim for payment.
- c. <u>County Resident Incentive Payment</u>. A payment made by Sherman County to qualified households in the County. The amount of the payment and whether or not it is made annually shall be at the sole, unfettered discretion of the County Court.
- d. <u>Occupied or Occupy</u>. "Occupied" or "occupy" means to live in or dwell in the household. Rights to claim under this Ordinance shall not be lost by the "occupant" being temporarily absent from the property, unless the property is rented to another during the absence. "Temporarily absent" shall mean a period not more than ninety (90) days in any calendar year.

## 3. <u>Section - Resident Incentive.</u>

After a claim is filed by a qualified Head of Household, it shall be reviewed by the County Staff appointed by the County Court. If approved by the Sherman County Court, the incentive amount shall be paid on or before December 15<sup>th</sup> of that calendar year.

#### 4. Section - Claim Procedure.

Forms for the purpose of making incentive payment claims shall be made available by the County on June 1<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year and claims made on such forms shall be filed with the County on or before August 31<sup>st</sup> of that same year. The claim must be made in writing on the appropriate form provided for such purpose. The claim shall set out the basis of the claim, designate the Household to which it applies, and contain such other information as the County requires. There shall be attached to each claim an affirmation of the claimant that the statements contained therein are true. The claim form must be complete and timely filed in order to qualify the Household for payment and no exceptions to this rule will be made.

#### 5. Section - Approval or Denial of Claim.

- a. All claims made under this Ordinance shall be reviewed and either approved or disallowed by the Sherman County staff person appointed by the County Court to perform such review.
- b. If the claim is disapproved, the claimant shall be notified in writing by certified mail sent to the address specified on the form. The notice shall state the reason for disapproval.
