SHERMAN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION IS SEEKING QUALIFIED **CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND GENERAL CONTRACTOR** SERVICES FOR SHERMAN COUNTY DIAL-A-RIDE BUS BARN PROJECT DUE DATE: October 22, 2021 no later than 5:00 pm REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL Background Sherman County Transportation is requesting proposals from qualified construction management/general contractor (CM/GC) to work with Sherman County Community Transportation (SCCT) to construct an approximate 2,576 square-foot 5 bay bus barn with one restroom within bus barn and 1 bay wash station. The building will be constructed on property designated by Sherman County for the purpose of construction of a bus barn located at 409 Hood Street, Moro, OR. The project is funded by various state grant funds.

It is the intent of SCCT to accept requests for proposals (RFP) for the construction of a new bus barn and wash station to any firm that meets the qualifications outlined in the minimum qualifications section of this RFP. Services that have been omitted from this RFP, which are clearly necessary for the completion of all work, shall be considered a requirement although not directly specified or called for in the proposal. This CM/GC project includes but is not limited to, the construction of a new 5 bay Bus Barn including a single bay washing station. All RFP documents, including the selection requirements and the selection schedule, will be available at the Sherman County Community Transportation office, 500 Court Street, Moro, OR 97039 October 4, 2021 or request that the packet be mailed or e-mailed upon request.
