

SOLANO COUNTY REGIS MEETING

Meeting Minutes – August 18, 2021



Stew called to order the regular meeting at 9:06 am on August 18, 2021 via Zoom.

I. Introductions

II. Approval of Meeting Minutes and New Business

- A. No questions nor comments were brought up for the July 21 meeting minutes and was accepted by the group.
- B. New Business:
 - 1. Suisun City (Roland): asking if other agencies have contracts with Interwest, their GIS consultant. The company seems to have internal staff restructuring and some have left for Infinity Technologies. Vacaville uses Interwest as well and is experiencing the same predicament.
- C. Nicole Braddock, Executive Director of [Solano Land Trust](#) with Ryan Branciforte - [OuterSpatial](#) presentation about their countywide parks and recreation project, [link to presentation](#).
 - 1. Map-based mobile app to locate [CA State Parks](#) within the community categorized by types of activities, similar to the AllTrails app but more. Other data includes parking, trails, PDF maps, parks, restroom facilities, etc. They would also like to provide red flag day warnings, so working with local fire agencies and emergency response.
 - 2. SLT is highly encouraging sharing data with them to improve the data for SC and the community we serve. Don and Stew are the main contacts, any information that will be shared by other cities should funnel through them.
 - 3. SLT uses maps daily and considers ReGIS peeps as “unsung heros” 😊
 - 4. Partnering with Kaiser Permanente with Take a Hike Challenge and other companies to get people to engage in outdoor activities.
- A. Workgroup Updates:
 - 1. Aerial Imagery (Stew) – final review Tuesday August 24, moving along well. Sanborn and Eagleview are vying for the contract. Eagleview has a more user-friendly oblique viewer, but Sanborn’s quote is more feasible, leaning more towards the latter. Multi-agency agreement will be forwarded to stakeholders soon. NO INCREASE FOR THE NEXT 6 YEARS. Looked into more partners for the contract, however most of the agencies are relatively small and may not monetarily contribute. TAFB may not sign the agreement but has contributed financially.
 - 2. NextGen911 Workgroup Updates (Stew) – GeoComm is working on the parcel update, street centerlines and address point layers, unsure if they’ll continue to work with the County after their contract has ended. SC is working on a countywide address point layer, many thanks

and high fives to the cities of Fairfield and Vacaville for sharing their data. 🙌🙌🙌 Next month SC plans to roll out an ArcGIS online EOC app. Working on integrating [Alert Solano app](#), live feed into SC EOC app. Also integrating fire calls into RIMS, special views for dispatch to city partners.

- B. GIS Surveys – should be completed within a week or so. Plans to have one focused on Governance priorities, the other to learn other agencies’ GIS projects and needs (later this year). Goal is to select the top 5 items (out of 20) as ReGIS’ framework. Recommendation is to limit the distribution of the questionnaire to IT/GIS staff.
- C. Datasharing agreement – SC has one in place but basically says all agencies in the consortium will have access to data, with the exemption to confidential data. Their Azure portal will serve as a one stop shop, REST services will also be available.

III. Action Items

- 1. Stew to request a demo of BCS Addresser tool.
- 2. All – think of potential presentations by vendors, consultants, other local public agencies.
- 3. All - Lightning Talk volunteers? Shital, Jasmin, Stew (Digital Twin, metaverse towards the end of the year).
