

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-40

RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CREATING A SUPERVISORIAL REDISTRICTING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, California Elections Code section 21500 requires the Board of Supervisors (Board) to adjust supervisorial district boundaries within the County after each decennial census, and using that census as a basis, so that the supervisorial districts remain substantially equal in population, as required by the United States Constitution; and

WHEREAS, new supervisorial district boundaries must be drawn in accordance with the criteria established in Section 21500 and shall comply with the United States Constitution, the California Constitution, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS, California Elections Code section 23001 allows the County to establish by resolution an advisory redistricting Committee composed of residents of the County to recommend to the Board changes to the supervisorial district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, California Elections Code section 23002 further provides that the County may determine the manner in which members are appointed to the advisory redistricting Committee, provided that members are not a County elected official, nor any family member, staff member, or paid campaign staff of a County elected official.

RESOLVED, the Solano County Board of Supervisors creates the Supervisorial Redistricting Advisory Committee ("Committee") comprised of 15 members with 3 members appointed by each Supervisor with at least one of the three members being a resident of the unincorporated area to provide input and recommendations to the Board on the need to change supervisorial district boundaries based upon on the 2020 Federal Decennial Census. Members

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Committee will be assisted in its efforts with staff support from the Technical Advisory Group comprised of representatives from the Department of Information Technology, including GIS Division and Registrar of Voters; Department of Resource Management Planning Division and County Surveyor; County Counsel; and County Administrator.
