### **DISCUSSION ITEM**

Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILOTs)

Presenter: Colin Driver, Director of Economic Development

- In the 2023 budget, each tax dollar was allocated so the school received 57.99%, the county received 12.33% and the borough received 29.69%.
- The school budget is presented to the town and if the town adopts it, that is the amount of money that has to be paid, regardless of the borough's finances.
- A PILOT is a payment in lieu of taxes and is not considered a tax by the government. It doesn't affect state aid and it helps to support the budget because PILOT revenue goes into the general fund.
- It provides the town with a long-term, stable flow of cash that can be anticipated
- PILOTs start when a Certificate of Occupancy is issued.
- If you have a healthy PILOT program, your taxes don't go up as much because they're offset by the income stream of the PILOT.
- The property owner still pays the land tax portion.
- The state set up PILOTS to incentivize developers to go into challenged communities.

- The owner cannot make a tax appeal to reduce payments as it is not a tax.
- In 2024, we are estimating to receive \$4,238,690 in revenue.
- The borough can use "other" sources of income to help fund the budget.
- Income from residential taxes is stabilized over time.
- School budget is funded without having to go into debt.
- · Borough receives a non-tax boost in income.
- · School can still receive state aid.
- The existing PILOT projects are estimated to inject between \$74 and \$104 million in personal disposable income into the local economy each year.
