WHEREAS, the bid received by Dell Tech, Inc., had a fatal material defect, the vendor failed to include page P-3 in the original and copied submission which consists of unit prices and is rejected; and

WHEREAS, the bid received by Spartan Construction, Inc., was substantially higher than the estimate and substantially higher than the appropriation for said project; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2(a) and (b) entitled rejection of bids states:

A contracting unit may reject all bids for any of the following reasons:

- (a) The lowest bid substantially exceeds the costs estimates for the goods and services.
- (b) The lowest bid substantially exceeds the contracting unit's appropriation for the goods or services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Somerville, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey hereby rejects all bids for the Somerville Borough Hall Entry Portico and Exterior Restoration Project as per reasons listed in the preamble and authorizes re-bid of said project.

AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT OF A TAX APPEAL FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 45 NORTH GASTON AVENUE, ALSO KNOWN AS BLOCK 66 LOT 16, IN THE BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE, SOMERSET COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, Mian Realty LLC, is the owner of certain real property located at 45 North Gaston Avenue, also known as block 66 lot 16, in the Borough of Somerville, Somerset County, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the owner has filed appeals to the Tax Court of New Jersey for said property for tax years 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023 under docket number 002201-2023; and

WHEREAS, the parties have engaged in settlement negotiations; and

WHEREAS, as a result of those settlement negotiations, a settlement has been reached on May 21, 2024, wherein the Borough of Somerville has agreed with the taxpayer to withdraw the Taxpayer's 2020 and 2021 tax court appeal and settle the remaining open appeals pursuant to a form of Stipulation agreed upon between both parties; and

WHEREAS, based on examination of the value and proper assessment of the property and appraisals, analysis and information with respect to the valuation and assessment of the property, the Borough of Somerville Tax Assessor has agreed to reduce the assessed value from \$1,504,200 to \$700,000 for both 2022 and 2023 tax years; and WHEREAS, as a result of the reduction of the assessment, a refund in the amount of \$30,245.96 for 2022 and a refund in the amount of \$31,058.20 for 2023 shall be made

payable to Jennifer R. Jacobus, Esq., Attorney for Mian Realty LLC within 60 days of the settlement; and

WHEREAS, Statutory interest pursuant to N.J.S.A 54:3-27.2 is waived by the taxpayer and shall not be paid on the condition the refund is received within 60 days from the date of the settlement; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree that the property's 2024 total assessment shall be reduced to \$625,000 and is reflected in the 2024 tax duplicate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Somerville, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that the settlement in this matter as set forth herein above is hereby approved and the Tax Collector is instructed to issue a total refund of \$61,304.16.

RECYCLING PROFESSIONAL (CRP)TO SIGN ANNUAL RECYCLING
TONNAGE REPORT

WHEREAS, BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE by ordinance, has duly enacted a recycling plan for all recyclable materials as designated by the Somerset County Solid Waste Management Plan and amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE is desirous of retaining CRP services of Somerset County for <u>signing</u> of said Annual Recycling Tonnage Report; and

WHEREAS, the award of this contract to the Somerset County pursuant to N.J.S.A. Section 13:1E-99.14 is an exception to the bidding requirements as set forth in the "Local Public Contracts Law" pursuant to N.J.S.A. Section 40A:11-5(2), and the Board of Chosen Commissioners for Somerset County.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, conditions, mutual benefits and covenants hereinafter set forth, the BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE and the Somerset County make this agreement.

- 1. BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE shall retain the services of the Somerset County for a CRP that will be responsible for signing the mandatory annual municipal recycling tonnage report, as provided in the Somerset County Solid Waste Management Plan, and with the State NJDEP. For the period commencing DATE: January 1, 2024 through and including DATE: December 31, 2024.
- It is understood that the responsibility for the accuracy of all tonnage and materials reported lies with the designated preparer of the Recycling Tonnage Report, which is the BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE municipal representative. The report preparer is responsible should the NJDEP audit the report submittal. BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE designates: Somerset County as the signer of the report as CRP.
- 3. It is the BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE's responsibility to retain the appropriate documentation for five years in the event of a field review.
- 4. The BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE reserves the right to reasonably amend the specifications of this Agreement by giving thirty (30) day written notification to Somerset County of any changes thereto.
- 5. If applicable, BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE shall pay a fee of \$45.27 per hour for the CRP's service to the COUNTY OF SOMERSET and will pay all invoices within thirty (30) days.
- 6. This agreement is the entire agreement between BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE and Somerset County and supersedes all previous agreements and discussions. Any amendments hereto must be in writing and must be duly executed by a BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE and Somerset County to become effective.
- 7. This Agreement will be entirely performed within the State of New Jersey and it shall be construed in accordance with the laws thereof.
- 8. If any provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, void, ultravires, or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

- <u>T. Mitchell -</u> We received two bids for the Borough Hall portico restoration project. The low bid was incomplete and unacceptable.
