Comments

<u>Mayor Sullivan</u> - The mayor asked about the surcharge rate (special improvement taxation levied on the properties in the district) and N. Pineiro confirmed it has not changed. The mayor said there are no individual homeowner taxes in this budget.

<u>N. Pineiro</u> - Our vacancy rate hasn't gone higher since the Covid peak. We had minimal vacancies during that time. Most of our properties are turning over quickly. There is a general desire for businesses to be in Somerville.

<u>G. Stravic</u> - I'm happy to see your budget reflecting an investment in trees again. Sidewalk repairs are needed, especially on the east side of Main Street. Also asked about the reserve fund balance, signage, and support for the Fire Department parade.

M. Kerwin - We're going to be looking at the reserve fund.

N. Piniero - Signage is incorporated in our streetscape plan, adopted this year. The DSA does not fund sidewalk improvements not related to the streetscape program.

<u>R. Vroom</u> - Code enforcement needs to walk around town and address any sidewalk issues. This is a conscientious budget that will benefit the businesses and residents.

The mayor called for a motion to accept the DSA 2024 introduced budget.

<u>G. Brady</u> - We are working on the 2024 budget, and we should be voting for a new budget in the spring. The temporary budget allows us to operate from January 1.

<u>T. Bonner</u> - December 8 is the last day for curbside leaf pickup. You can still bag leaves and call DPW to pick them up. The Turkey Trot 5K was a huge success, with over 1,350 participants. The Recreation Department raised \$35,000 towards the installation of 2 new inclusive playgrounds. Registration is open for the wrestling league, basketball league and basketball clinic.

<u>R. Pitts</u> - The Police Department is hosting the Holiday Fill a Cruiser Blanket Drive on Saturday. They are collecting new blankets, paper towels and toilet paper for distribution to local families. The Holiday Jubilee was rescheduled to December 15.
