RESOLUTION 22-0815-259

APPROVING OKTOBERFEST AND ROAD CLOSURE ON NORTH BRIDGE STREET BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND HIGH STREET ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2022 FROM NOON TO 10:00 P.M.

WHEREAS, the Oktoberfest Fest is schedule to take place on Saturday, October 1, 2022 from noon to 10:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the festival will be utilizing North Bridge Street from Main Street to High Street; and

WHEREAS, the organizers must complete the road closure and police request forms and make payment to the Police Off-Duty escrow prior to scheduling of officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Somerville, hereby approve the Oktoberfest to take place on Saturday, October 1, 2022 from noon to 10:00 p.m., on North Bridge Street from Main Street to High Street contingent on the submission of the appropriate forms and payment to the Police Off-Duty escrow prior to scheduling of Off-Duty Police Officers.

RESOLUTION 22-0815-260

RESOLUTION APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM MUNICIPAL COURT ADMINISTRATOR JENNI PETERSON JULY 18, 2022 ENDING JULY 17, 2023

WHEREAS, Jenni Peterson was hired on July 18, 2022 as the Municipal Court Administrator as established in the shared services agreement with Borough of Somerville; and

WHEREAS, Jenni Peterson is currently considered an interim Municipal Court Administrator pursuant to NJSA 2B:12€ since she was hired after May 25, 2011 and does not hold a municipal court administrator certificate; and

WHEREAS, the statute allows the governing body to appoint a person as a Municipal Court Administrator that is no a certified Municipal Court Administrator, on an interim basis, for a period not to exceed one year commencing on the date of the appointment July 18, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the stature further states, "Any person so appointed may, in consultation with the judge of the municipal court, be reappointed as a municipal administrator, on an Interim basis, for two subsequent one-year terms. The municipal court administrator appointed on an interim basis may be reappointed for a fourth, and, if necessary, a fifth additional one-year term, provided the municipal court administrator is currently enrolled in the certification program and needs additional time to complete that program".

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Somerville, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that it hereby appoints Jenni Peterson as Interim Municipal Court Administrator for a one-year term commencing July 18, 2022 ending July 17, 2023.

RESOLUTION 22-0815-261

APPROVING TAX SALE COSTS 2022

WHEREAS, NJSA 54:5-19.1 authorizes electronic tax sales pursuant to rules and regulations to be promulgated by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

WHEREAS, the rules and regulations require a municipality to send two (2) notices of tax sale to all properties included in said sale; and

WHEREAS, the rules and regulations allow said municipality to charge a fee of up to \$25.00 per notice for the creation, printing and mailing of said notice; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to NJSA 54:5-38, the officer conducting a tax sale shall collect and pay into the municipal treasury a fee for all costs incurred by the municipality in holding the sale. The amount of fee so paid shall be 2% of the existing lien as stated in NJSA 54:4-19 and 54:5-2 but not less than \$15.00 and not more than \$100.00 for each parcel in the sale; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Somerville wishes to charge \$25.00 per notice mailed which will be assessed specifically to the delinquent accounts that are causing the need for a tax sale and not to the general tax base and 2% of the existing lien as stated in NJSA 54:4-19 and 54:5-2 but not less than \$15.00 and not more than \$100.00 for each parcel in the sale.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Somerville that a fee of \$25.00 per notice be established and is hereby authorized and directed to be charged for each notice of tax sale that is sent in conjunction with the 2022 electronic tax sale.

RESOLUTION 22-0815-262

APPROVING THE HIRING OF JAMES SANSEVERINO AS DRIVER LABORER FOR DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Somerville advertised for the full time position of Driver Laborer for Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, it's recommended the hiring of James Sanseverino at an annual salary of \$44,000, prorated for 2022 depending on start date and contingent upon a satisfactory background check.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Somerville, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey authorizes the hiring of James Sanseverino at an annual salary of \$44,000 prorated for 2022 with an anticipated start date of August 22, 2022.

RESOLUTION 22-0815-263

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN LAND AND PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE BY BOROUGH OF SOMERVILLE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Somerville is the owner of certain lands and capital improvements within the Borough of Somerville; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Borough of Somerville does hereby determine that the lands and properties set forth in Schedule A are no longer needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Somerville desires to make available for public sale said lands in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Somerville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Council hereby declares that the lands and premises set forth in Schedule A are no longer needed for public use and should be sold in accordance with the appropriate statutes of the State of New Jersey and ordinances of the Borough of Somerville.

SECTION 2. The Borough of Somerville hereby authorizes Max Spann Real Estate & Auction Co. (hereinafter "Auctioneer"), to offer for sale to the highest bidder by open public sale at auction, the property described in Schedule A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The online public sale on _____ or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard and publicly announced, provided the sale is not canceled.

SECTION 4. The online public sale, if not canceled, shall take place by open public sale at auction to the highest bidder.

SECTION 5. All bidders at the time of sale must present a certified check, money wire or money order in the amount of \$5,000.00 payable to themselves (to be endorsed to the escrow holder or its designee if successful). In addition, the successful bidder shall submit a personal check or money order for the balance of the deposit of 10% of the minimum bid plus Buyer's Premium at the conclusion of the auction and shall execute an Agreement of Sale. Said Agreement of Sale shall be binding upon the high bidder until such time that the municipal council either 1) does not accept the bid in which case bidders deposit will be returned, or, 2) accepts the bid whereupon the municipality shall execute the Agreement of Sale and both parties shall be held bound by the terms and conditions contained therein. The balance of the purchase price shall be paid at closing which shall occur not later than 45 days following the acceptance of the bid by the Borough. The purchaser shall be entitled to possession immediately following closing of title.

SECTION 6. At closing of title, purchaser shall also pay a buyer's premium in the amount of ten (10%) percent of the bid amount to Auctioneer to conduct the sale.

SECTION 7. In the event the Borough of Somerville is unable to convey clear and marketable title, insurable at regular rates by a title insurance company licensed to do business in the State of New Jersey, the Borough of Somerville will forthwith return to the purchaser any and all deposit moneys previously submitted by the purchaser, and neither party shall have any further rights against the other. The acceptance of a deed by the purchaser from the Borough shall extinguish any claims that said purchaser may have against the Borough of Somerville in connection with the quality of title conveyed.

SECTION 8. The property herein sold is subject to existing encumbrances, liens, easements, zoning ordinances, other restrictions of record, such facts as an accurate survey would reveal and any present or future assessments for the construction of improvements benefiting said property. Neither the Borough of Somerville nor the Auctioneer make no representations as to the presence or absence of wetlands or any other environmental conditions on the property and the purchaser assumes the risk of any such condition, all property being sold "as is."

SECTION 9. All conveyances by the Borough of Somerville shall be made by Bargain and Sale Deed with Covenants Against Grantor's Acts.

SECTION 10. The Borough of Somerville reserves the right to waive any and all defects and informalities in any bid and to accept or reject any and all bids at the public sale and to not award to the highest bidder. No bid shall be considered finally accepted until passage of a resolution by the Municipal Council as set forth in Paragraph 12 hereof.

SECTION 11. Acceptable bids shall be confirmed by resolution of the Municipal Council no later than the first regular meeting of the Municipal Council following the date of such sale.

SECTION 12. This Ordinance shall constitute and serve as the public notice to be published in a newspaper circulating in the Borough at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks, the last publication being not earlier those seven (7) days prior to the date set forth for the public sale.

SECTION 13.In the event the successful bidder fails to close on the property, he shall forfeit the ten percent (10%) deposit.

SECTION 14. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

Council President RanD Pitts said the reports were listed in the agenda.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- <u>G. Brady -</u> We're having some work done on Lisa Terrace, Lori Drive, Lee Way and parts of Reimer Street. Residents and visitors to those streets will have to park offsite.
- <u>G. Stravic -</u> Now is the time to order a street tree. The Environmental Commission is planning an Oct. 10 event to plant the Salem Oak in collaboration with the Wallace House.
- <u>T. Mitchell</u> Newark Penn Station will undergo major renovations as a part of a \$191 million restoration plan that was announced by Governor Phil Murphy.
- A \$1 billion improvement plan for the PATH commuter line has been recognized by the American Public Transit Association (APTA). This program is already accommodating nine-car trains at stations on the Newark-World Trade Center line, and has updated the Exchange Place Station in Jersey City with longer platforms and added an additional passenger connection between Newark and New York bound platforms.

<u>Amanda Rivers - Expressed concern about the pavement on Hamilton and South Side Avenue. Also asked about the railroad station parking.</u>

<u>Colin Driver, Director of Economic Development -</u> When the project is finished there will be parking in front of the station entrance and in the deck across the street on Veterans Memorial Drive. Passenger pickup will be in front of the station or from the large plaza at the development currently under construction.

R. Pitts - We need to look into the question about road paving with the Department of Public Works.

<u>Mateo Garcia -</u> Thanked the governing body for the rumble strips on the roads coming off Rt. 22. Also thanked the Borough for planning to repair the Mercer St. basketball court and noted that the work did not start on Monday, August 15 as advertised on social media.

We need to make sure all our sidewalks are accessible for wheelchairs and walkers for the elderly. There's a long stretch of sidewalk on Main Street near the YMCA that needs repair along with the sidewalk on Cliff Street, across from the middle school.

He urged the governing body to assess our parks and repurpose the land that we have for uses that the residents want. He suggested getting input from the community.

He suggested more open tables for seating in the town.

<u>K. Sluka - The Downtown Somerville Alliance (DSA) just started a capital infrastructure study and is looking at the things that are important in a downtown, like seating.</u>

<u>G. Stravic -</u> I think some of the streets mentioned are not the town's responsibility to repair.

<u>K. Sluka</u> - Sidewalks are the property owner's responsibility. If we get complaints, we put the owners on notice and the owner can use our assessment program and get on a list for repairs at cost or they can repair on their own. We do about 12 sidewalks at once for a better value.

<u>Mateo Garcia</u> - Suggested more proactive communication with homeowners about this program.
