Nomination letters should include the following key elements:

- **Description of the Artist's Work:** Provide an overview of the nominee's artistic style and achievements.
- **Photos or Portfolio:** Include photographs or a link to the artist's work.
- **Contributions to the Community:** Describe how the nominee has impacted the Sonoma Valley community through their artistry and community involvement.
- **Rationale for Nomination:** Share compelling reasons why this individual should be honored as the Treasure Artist of the Year.

The submission deadline for nominations is October 31, 2024, allowing ample time for the Commission to carefully review and consider each candidate. Following the nomination period, the Commission will convene to select the Treasure Artist of the Year at their November 19, 2024, meeting.
