New State Recycling Requirement for Businesses and Multifamily Residences

California Assembly Bill (AB341) California's New Mandatory Commercial Recycling Law take effect on July 1, 2012 requiring all businesses that generate four (4) or more cubic yards of waste per week to recycle. Businesses include any commercial or public entity, including non-profits, retail centers and school facilities. AB341 also requires all multi-family dwellings of five (5) or more units to recycle.

The purpose of the law is to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by diverting commercial solid waste to recycling efforts.
