

## Cannabis Regulations for Napa County Jurisdictions as of March 26, 2018

**Note:** After third countywide roundtable in September all jurisdictions will look a revising ordinances by January 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.

<b>County</b>	<p>3/26/18: Verified information in Napa County Code Chapter 8.10.</p> <p>Medicinal</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows indoor grow up to 6 plants per SFD or accessory structure on SFD property.</li> <li>• Allows possession of dried (beyond State minimums).</li> <li>• Allows delivery.</li> <li>• Prohibits: outdoor grow, dispensary, collective, and manufacturing.</li> </ul> <p>Recreational</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prohibits all activities associated with recreational cannabis.</li> </ul>
<b>Napa</b>	<p>3/26/18: Verified information in Ordinance 02017-018 (<a href="http://www.cityofnapa.org/documentcenter/view/2322">http://www.cityofnapa.org/documentcenter/view/2322</a>)</p> <p>Medicinal Cannabis Retailers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allowed in following zoning districts: Medical Office, Light Industrial, and Industrial Park-Area.</li> <li>• Not located on a property that is within 1,000 feet of any youth oriented property.</li> <li>• May not be located on a property that directly abuts, or is directly across the street from, a residential zoning district; with the exception that a medicinal cannabis retailer may be located on a property directly abutting the back yard of a residential zoning district.</li> </ul> <p>Small Cannabis Manufacturers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allowed in following zoning districts: Light Industrial, Industrial Park-Area and C.</li> <li>• Not located on a property that is within 1,000 feet of any youth oriented property.</li> <li>• Not located on a property that directly abuts, or is across the street from, a residential zoning district.</li> </ul> <p>Cultivation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows indoor</li> <li>• Allows outdoor grow</li> <li>• Limited to six living cannabis plants.</li> </ul> <p>Commercial: Prohibited</p>
<b>Yountville</b>	<p>3/26/18: Verified information in Municipal Cod 9.30. February 26, 2018 hosted a Yountville Community Cannabis Forum.</p> <p>Medicinal</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prohibits all medicinal by ordinance.</li> </ul> <p>Personal Use Cultivation</p>

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- Limited to six plants or 50 contiguous square feet (whichever is less).

Delivery: Allowed with valid delivery permit.

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### St. Helena

3/26/18: Verified information in Municipal Code section 17.126.030.

#### Medicinal

- Allows indoor grow up to 6 mature and 12 immature, 100 sq. ft. maximum.
- Allows delivery for care giver to patient only.
- Prohibits: outdoor grow, dispensary, collective, and manufacturing.

#### Recreational

- Prohibits all activities associated with recreational cannabis.

Dispensaries: Prohibited.

Cultivation Facilities: Prohibited

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### Calistoga

3/26/18: Verified information in Municipal Code section 8.30 and 17.48.040.

#### Medicinal/Recreational

- Allow up to 6 plants per SFD or accessory structure.
  - Allows outdoor grow in following zoning districts: Rural Residential (RR), Rural Residential-Hillside (RR-H), One-Family Residential (R-1 and R-1-10), and Planned Development District (PD).
  - Outdoor cultivation is prohibited on a parcel that is within 300 feet of a school, religious facility, park, child care facility, recreation center or youth-oriented facility. The distance shall be measured in a straight line, without regard to intervening structures, from the closest property line of the parcel on which the outdoor cultivation is occurring. Outdoor cultivation must be enclosed by a solid fence at least six feet in height.
  - Marijuana plants may not be visible from a public right-of-way or neighboring property at ground level.
  - Allows delivery.
  - Prohibits: dispensary, collective, and manufacturing.
  - The use of compressed, flammable gas as a solvent in the extraction of tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) or other cannabinoids to cultivate marijuana is prohibited.
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### American Canyon

3/26/18: Verified information in Municipal Code section 19.51.

#### Medicinal

- Allows indoor grows up to 6 plants per SD or accessory structure on SFD property.
- Prohibits: outdoor grows, dispensaries, collectives, manufacturing, and delivery.

#### Recreational

- Allows indoor grows up to 6 plants per SD or accessory structure on SFD property.
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
