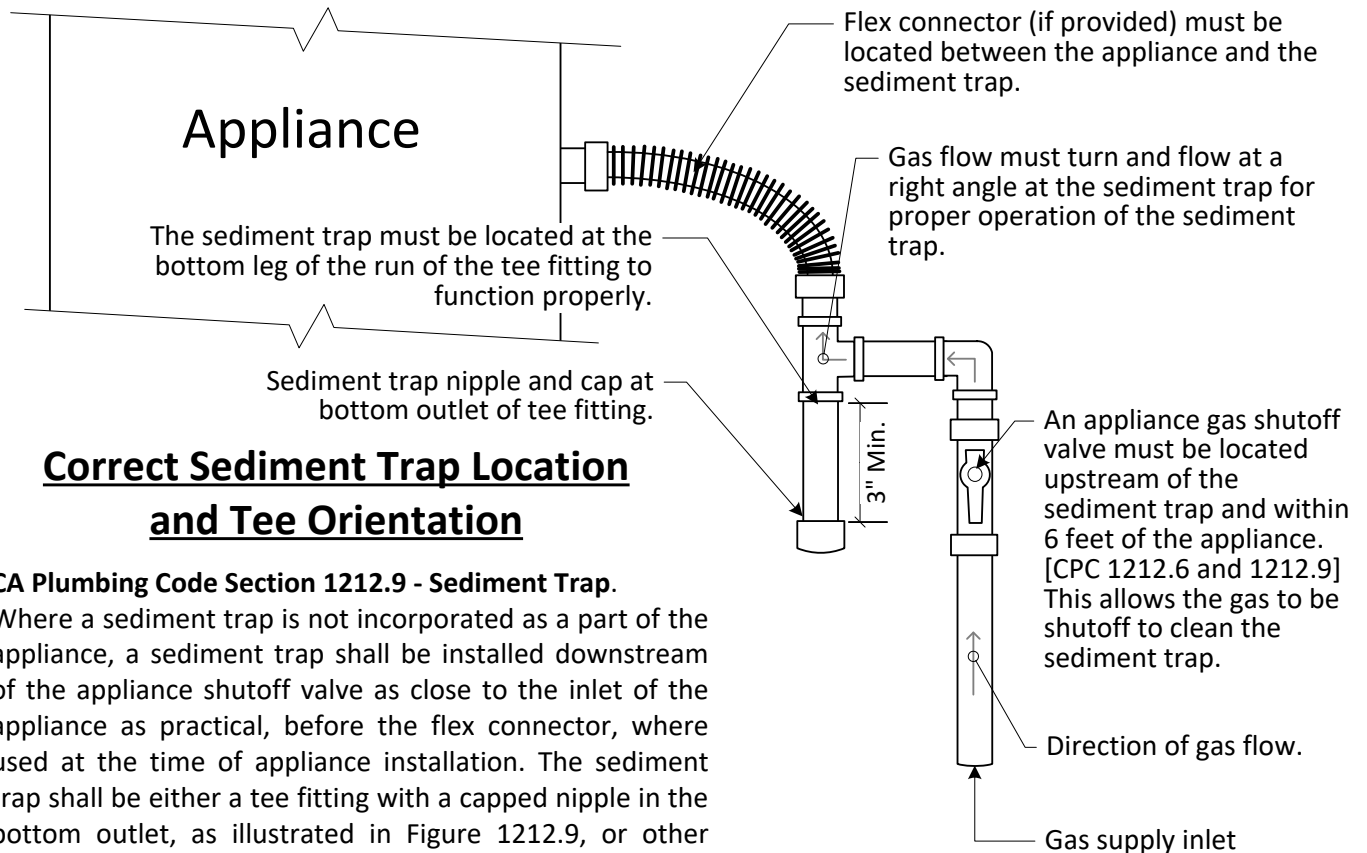




## Requirements for Gas Sediment Trap

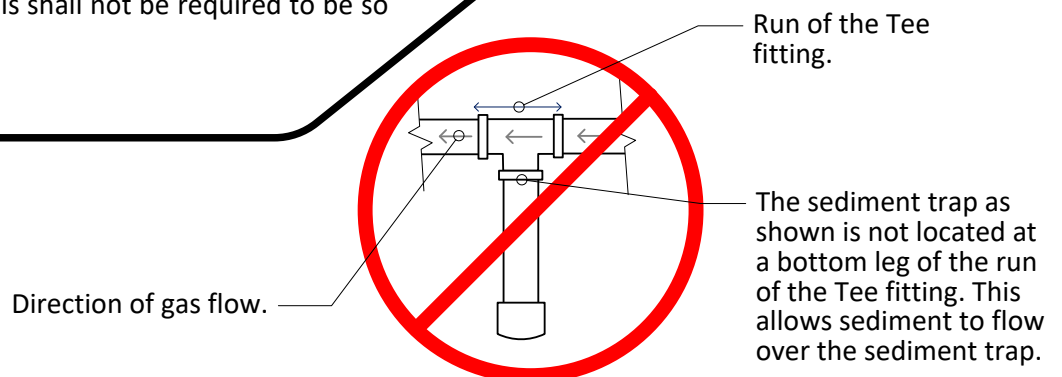
The following illustrates and explains the requirements for gas sediment traps pursuant to Section 1212.9 of the CA Plumbing Code (CPC).



### Correct Sediment Trap Location and Tee Orientation

#### **CA Plumbing Code Section 1212.9 - Sediment Trap.**

Where a sediment trap is not incorporated as a part of the appliance, a sediment trap shall be installed downstream of the appliance shutoff valve as close to the inlet of the appliance as practical, before the flex connector, where used at the time of appliance installation. The sediment trap shall be either a tee fitting with a capped nipple in the bottom outlet, as illustrated in Figure 1212.9, or other device recognized as an effective sediment trap. Illuminating appliances, ranges, clothes dryers, decorative appliances for installation in vented fireplaces, gas fireplaces, and outdoor grills shall not be required to be so equipped.
