Hi Paul,

I just wanted to follow up on our agreement recited on the record of the Planning Commission hearing on Verizon's 3 small cell applications on November 8, 2018. We agreed that each of the dates in the "Modifications to August 6 Agreement re: Verizon small cell applications" agreement ("Modifications Agreement") be extended for a two-month period. The extension period was arrived at on the basis of Verizon's representation at the November 8 hearing that it would present revised designs to staff within 30 days of the hearing. The new dates that would apply are as follows:

1. The City shall make a final determination on the 3 commercial applications by no later than May 4, 2019.
2. By no later than May 31, 2019, Verizon will notify the City in writing whether it is re-initiating the processing and consideration of the 7 residential applications (S-002, S-004, S-008, S-011, S-014, S-016, and S-017).
3. The Planning Commission shall make a determination with written findings on the 7 residential applications by no later than August 30, 2019. The City shall make a final determination on the 7 residential applications by no later than November 30, 2019.

Naturally, except as set forth above, the terms of the Modifications Agreement and original August 6, 2018 Letter Agreement shall remain in effect.

Please reply to this email to confirm that this comports with your and your client's understanding of the agreement that was made at the November 8<sup>th</sup> hearing.
