

Have you been exposed to COVID-19? Sonoma County resources are available.



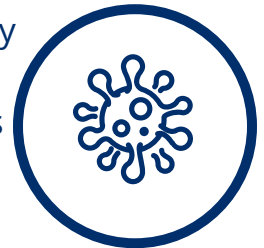
In need of food?

Community members in need of food -- resources are available to you at no cost. If you are in isolation, unable to coordinate food delivery, been affected by COVID-19, cannot afford food or are experiencing homelessness, Sonoma County can help. Text "Food" to 707-353-6333 to find out where to get food near you.



Need testing?

Free, convenient, and confidential COVID-19 testing is available for all Sonoma County residents, regardless of documentation status. No ID is required. Everyone is allowed to receive a test, regardless if they are symptomatic or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19. Call 2-1-1 to learn about different testing options.



Need Financial Assistance?

Sonoma County offers various resources for residents who are experiencing financial hardship. Community members who have been exposed or tested positive for COVID-19 may be eligible for wage replacement while in isolation. Rent and mortgage support is available to residents who have been impacted by COVID-19. Rent and mortgage support can be used to pay utility bills.



Additional Support

To better provide for the community at large, Sonoma County has partnered with local and state organizations to provide wrap around services. The County is offering free mental health services, alternative care sites for isolation, rapid rehousing, recovery counseling services, infant care supplies, and rental legal services.
