CITY OF SONOMA PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR BACKFLOW TESTING AND CERTIFICATION

SECTION 1 INTRODUCTION

The City of Sonoma invites qualified Contractors to submit a proposal to provide testing services for City owned backflow devices installed on the City of Sonoma water system.

Background: The City currently provides potable water to approximately 4,600 connections within their service area. Historically, most of the City's water has been provided by the Sonoma County Water Agency (SCWA), with the balance provided by City-owned wells. The service area currently comprises of approximately 1,546 acres and is anticipated to grow. Within this water system, the City of Sonoma operates 50 locations with backflow devices to prevent drinking water from being contaminated by other water sources. As part of the State Water Board's requirements upon the City of Sonoma, these devices must be tested and certified annually (17 CCR §7605).

Scope of Services: The Contractor shall perform testing of City of Sonoma owned backflow devices installed at City owned locations. The work to be done under this contract consists of testing and certification of each backflow device, providing cost estimates for any repair work, and repairing as directed under the pricing provided in this proposal. A sample City Professional Services Agreement is included as Attachment A. A list of backflow devices is included as Exhibit C and a sample Backflow Prevention Assembly Test Report is included as Exhibit D in Attachment A.

SECTION 2 CONTENTS OF PROPOSAL

To maintain uniformity in the evaluation process, proposal length is limited to a maximum of 5 pages on single-sided, 8½" x 11" paper. Use text font (ARIAL, TAHOMA, or similar) size 10 or larger. The cover letter, table of contents, front and back covers, and section dividers and resumes are excluded from the page count.

The Proposal Package must include following:

a) Cover Letter

Include the primary contractor's name and business address, as well as the project manager's name, telephone number and email address. Summarize your understanding of the project and demonstrate expertise that would meet the minimum qualifications laid out in Section 2(d). The cover letter shall be

signed by the person authorized to negotiate a contract for proposed services with the City of Sonoma on behalf of submitting firm.

b) Relevant Project Experience

Describe your team's experience on projects of a similar nature to this Project. Provide a project description, services provided, rates, the project's total cost, and references.

c) Scope of Services

Confirm acceptance of the proposed scope of services and identify any changes from the scope herein and in Attachment A.

d) Required Certifications and Minimum Qualifications (not included in page count)

Included with proposal the following documentation for review.

- Backflow Tester Certification for Each Tester
- Backflow gauge's current calibration certificates for each gauge
- Valid Contractor's License
- City of Sonoma business license
- Insurable for coverage limits for Commercial General and Automobile Liabilities and Workers Compensation and Employers Liability as required as described in Attachment A.

e) Proposed Fee Schedule

Please provide pricing according to the following fee schedule. Provide a uniform price to test and inspect any City of Sonoma owned backflow devices. Provide hourly repair rate that will be used in any repair recommendation provided by the contractor following testing and inspection work. Provide any other necessary pricing and description.

The City reserves the right to seek additional information and/or clarification from the respondent, the right to confer with any respondent submitting a response and the right to reject any or all responses with or without cause. In the event that the RFP is withdrawn by the City for any reason, the City shall have no liability to any respondent for any costs or expense incurred with the preparation of this RFP or related work. The City reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to waive any irregularities or informality.

The City reserves the right to reject any and/or all responses for failure to meet the requirements contained herein, to waive any technicalities and to select the responses which, in the City's sole judgment, best meets the requirements of the project.
