<sup>\*</sup>The fees quoted above are for 10'x10' stall unless it is the NEW Food Truck Vendor Category. The prepared food vendors pay either the flat stall fee or 10% gross receipts, whichever is higher.

- ❖ The main focus of Sonoma's Tuesday Night Market (STNM) is making fresh, healthy, locally grown produce from small-scale farmers available to our community. And provide a community gathering place for our residents of Sonoma Valley.
- ❖ In evaluating food vendor applications to STNM, we consider the following criteria: Fresh, in-season, locally sourced ingredients, purchased from STNM farmer vendors whenever possible; compostable, polyethylene-free packaging and utensils; small-scale, locally based businesses; high-quality, affordable options for purchase; compliance with all applicable local, county and state ordinances and permitting.
- All accepted vendors must read and comply with the Sonoma's Tuesday Night Market Rules and Regulations found on the vendor page, at <a href="https://www.SonomasTuesdayNightMarket.com"><u>www.SonomasTuesdayNightMarket.com</u></a>.
- ❖ Enclose your payment! Applications without the \$45 application fee will not be considered! Any late applications received after the January 31, 2023; deadline must pay a late application penalty fee of \$30. Total Late Application Fee is \$75.

## **Important Notes for 2023**

- ❖ We expect the 2023 Market reach full or nearly full booth capacities. The City of Sonoma and Sonoma Valley Chamber of Commerce continue to partner to present STNM for 2023. The Market operates from May through end of September, a total of 20 market nights. There will be no market the weeks of July 4 and August 1, 2023 due to other community events scheduled those weeks.
- ❖ Stall Fees: Due to Fire Department Regulations, most prepared food vendors will be required to rent 10'x15' stalls. Prepared Food Vendors will be tiered, based on your required space, business location, or 10% of nightly gross income: Within Sonoma city limits \$75 per 10'x10' stall; within Sonoma Valley (south of Oakmont, north of Highway 37) \$86; outside of Sonoma Valley but within Sonoma County \$98; outside of Sonoma County \$110. If you require a 10'x15' footprint and are within Sonoma Valley, your weekly rate would be \$112.50. \$75, plus \$37.50 for the additional 5' or 10% of gross income whichever is higher. All Prepared Food Vendors will be required to provide verifiable sales reports from a cash register or point-of-sale system.
- ❖ Please note: effective March 1, 2019 the use of single use plastics at Plaza events is prohibited. This includes all plastic beverage containers (bottled water), plastic bags, utensils, plastic plates and cups. There are a variety of plant-based paper products that can be used. Please be sure to choose a brand that does not contain a high wax/plastic polymer coating. Local retailers will be posted on our website.
- ❖ A volunteer Market Advisory Committee made up of local citizens will review all vendor applications during the month of February, using objective criteria determined by the City of Sonoma and Sonoma Valley Chamber of Commerce. Vendor applicants will be notified by March 1, 2023, if they have been accepted into the 2023 Sonoma's Tuesday Night Market. Any vendor applicant may appeal the Market Advisory Committee's decision.
- ❖ We are excited to welcome former vendors to our 2023 season. Any new changes and procedures are designed to ensure a fair, unbiased selection process, a safe and well-run market for patrons and vendors, and a welcoming event for our community, including our Plaza merchants and restaurants.
- ❖ The Fire Marshall will inspect all food vendors on Market Opening Day. If your booth is not in compliance with fire regulations (current fire extinguisher, pavement protection under cooking units, propane tanks secured, cooking area barricaded from the public, etc.), you will be shut down for the night and will still owe your stall fee for the night. Be sure you are completely in compliance on Opening Day—NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- New to 2023 market season by applying to participate in the market you are committing to participate in all 20 of the nightly markets. All vendors will be required to pay for their stall fee regardless of attendance.

	If my Prepared Food business is accepted to participate as a vendor in the 2023 Market season, I understand that I will be required to provide a verifiable sales report of my gross sales from a cash register or point-of-sale system for each Market that I
	attend.  I understand that City of Sonoma records, including this application, attachments and emails, are subject to the California Public Records Act.
	I understand that if I no show for a market I am responsible for paying my nightly stall fees. And I will make every attempt to notify the market manager via email manager@sonomastuesdaynightmarket.com of my absence.

I certify that the information contained in the foregoing application is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. I have read, understand and agree to abide by the rules and regulations governing the proposed Special Activity or Event under the City of Sonoma Municipal Code. I understand that this application is made subject to the rules and regulations established by the City Council and/or the City Manager or the City Manager's designee. I agree to comply with all other requirements of the City, County, State, Federal Government, and any other applicable entity which may pertain to the use of the event venue and the conduct of the event. I agree to abide by all rules, regulations and permit conditions and further certify that I, on behalf of the Vendor organization, am also authorized to commit that organization, and therefore agree to be financially responsible for any cost and fees that may be incurred by or on behalf of the vendor to the City of Sonoma. arising out of or in connection with Sonoma's Tuesday Night Farmers Market or the intentional or negligent acts, errors or omissions of the Applicant, volunteers, agents and event participants, including those caused by negligence of the parties being indemnified and/or any dangerous condition of property of the parties being indemnified.
