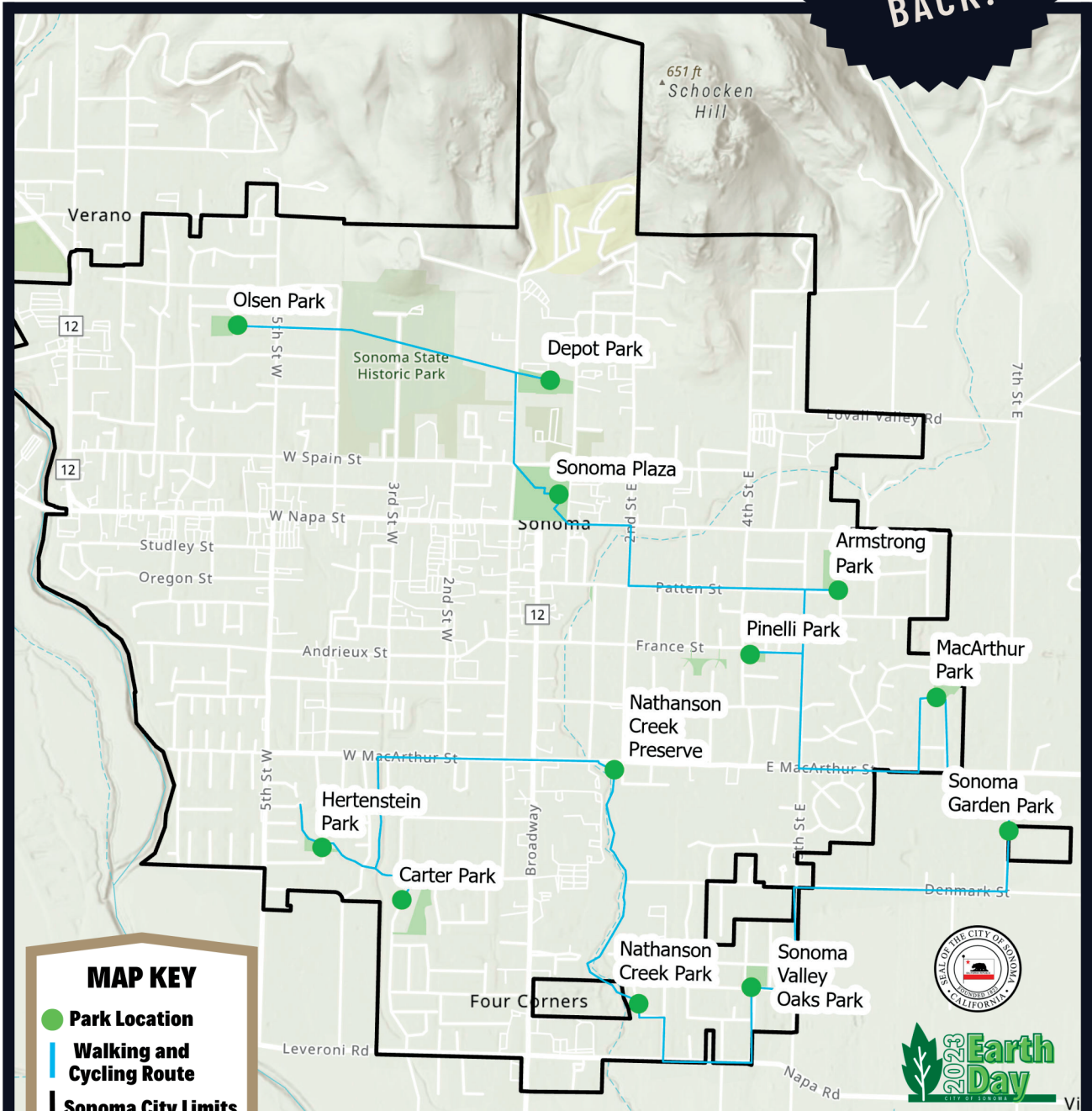

Visit Sonoma's 12 City parks to complete the scavenger hunt and return this form to City Hall by April 28th for a chance to win a prize!

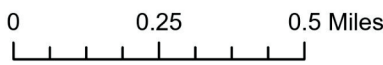
