NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH HAS DETERMINED THAT THE ABOVE-REFERENCED PROPERTY IS IN VIOLATION OF THE SONOMA COMPLEX FIRE CLEANUP EMERGENCY ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE NO. 6211 AND 6211(A)), AND SUBJECT TO SUMMARY ABATEMENT AS A PUBLIC NUISANCE DUE TO THE EXISTENCE OF HAZARDOUS FIRE DEBRIS FROM THE SONOMA COMPLEX FIRES.

This hazardous fire debris has resulted in emergency conditions, including the conditions on your property, which seriously endanger the public health and/or safety. Unless you take immediate action, the County will enter your property and forcefully remove all hazardous fire debris. If your property is abated through this summary abatement process, slabs and foundations will be removed. You will be charged for all related costs and a lien may be placed on your property.

Our records indicate that you have not submitted a Right of Entry form nor an Alternative Program Application. If this is incorrect, or if you wish to discuss these options, please immediately contact Sonoma County Environmental Health at (707) 565-6700.

The Director of Environmental Health has made findings and issued an Emergency Order that your property is subject to emergency abatement. That Emergency Order is available on the internet at: <https://www.sonomacountyrecovers.org/>.

If you dispute the Director of Environmental Health summary abatement determination, you must submit a written Appeal of the Notice and Order within **14 calendar days** of the date of this Notice.
