



DISASTER RECOVERY CENTER

Thank you for coming, we are here to assist you in your recovery from the 2017 October Firestorm. We are a group of community organizations across the county that have come together to provide the most resources to the most people.

What's available?



We have a wide range of services and forms of assistance that we can connect you to once we know your needs, including housing support, financial assistance and counseling, mental health support, food access, furniture, clothes and other unmet needs. This will help you avoid visiting multiple agencies to find resources on your own.



What will happen first?

A ROC intake specialist will sit down with you and review your needs to get an understanding of how the disaster impacted and continues to impact your life. Once we have reviewed that information we can figure out the type of assistance available to you.



What if I've already filled out forms at another partner agency?

The benefit of working with us is that we will work together to make sure that we have all the needed information. With your permission, we will contact our partner agencies to gather this information.



What happens next?

We will connect you to resources for your needs. If you have a complex situation that will require long term support we will connect you to a disaster case manager.

What is disaster case management?



If you are assigned a Case Manager they will walk the path of recovery with you until you have come as close as possible to where you were the day before the fires. This includes a more in depth assessment, creating a recovery plan, helping you navigate recovery resources for rebuilding, housing, employment and other needs. Case managers can advocate for you with organizations like FEMA and insurance companies and connect you to partners.

Who is ROC?

We are a group of community based organizations that have come together to form a Long Term Recovery Group called **Rebuilding Our Community (ROC) Sonoma County**. Our goal is to support long term recovery efforts in Sonoma County.
