Chief Reinholz said in the past two weeks there had been a successful cardiac arrest resuscitation, there was a minor fire, the ISO grading evaluation had been completed but they were waiting for the grade to be announced, and the Fire Department would soon start the spring company inspections for the small businesses.

Mr. Mytinger reported that the Parks and Recreation Department had 99% moved in to the new Community Center. They were still finalizing some IT issues. The first event would be a St. Patrick's Day luncheon for the Seniors with about 100 participants. Next week on Monday, March 18, 2024 would be the soft open for the offices and the Ribbon Cutting ceremony was scheduled for Wednesday evening, March 20, 2024 at 6 p.m. with an Open House till 8 p.m. The Mayor's State of the City breakfast would be the next morning, Thursday, March 21, 2024. The Department was looking forward to an exciting time.

Mr. Czekaj announced that he was still waiting to hear from the Department of Development regarding the grant for the Arrowhead subdivision waterline project. The Engineering Department had opened bids for the City Center Activity Area Project (splashpad and restroom). The bids came in close to the engineer's estimate at about \$1.6 million. The construction for that project would start about May 15 and be completed by August 30, 2024. The City Center Infrastructure package was to be completed by about May 15, 2024.

Mr. O'Malia had spoken at the high school today about the importance of having a Plan B and there were a lot of quality jobs in Streetsboro. There would be a Career Fair at the high school on Wednesday, March 13, 2024. On Wednesday, March 20, 2024 there would be a Community Reinvestment Area Housing Council Meeting to review all the CRA tax incentives of the previous year. He requested an executive session at the March 25, 2024 Finance Committee meeting to go over the existing and pending economic development deals.
