Agricultural Placement Renewal Request of Terrence and Moira Horner 8829 Diagonal Road, Streetsboro, Ohio, Portage County, 12.35 acres

Mr. Hannan opened the floor for comments. There were no comments, but Mr. Hannan asked for a clear explanation of an agricultural placement. Mrs. McDaniel said she had talked with Matt Kelly, the County Auditor, recently to learn more about agricultural placements. She learned that agricultural placements are a companion to CAUV (a tax incentive for agricultural land). The agricultural placements do a couple of things: they protect the landowner from nuisance lawsuits, and help to protect in cases of eminent domain, and they protect against large assessments. If a land owner had a lot of frontage, like many agricultural lands do, it protected them if utilities were coming in and they were being asked to pay an assessment that was way more than the average property owners because they had so much frontage. The agricultural placement offered the land owner some protections and had to be renewed every five years by the people that qualified.

There being no further business to be addressed during this Public Hearing, and upon motion by Mr. Ring, seconded by Mr. Lombardo, this meeting adjourned at 7:04 p.m.
